# LTG Blum Opens the 2006 National Matches

On 10 July 2006, National Match competitors, officials, staff, volunteers and visitors gathered on Rodriguez Range for the Annual First Shot Ceremony. The First Shot Ceremony is the traditional opening for the National Matches. Lieutenant General H Steven Blum, the Chief of the National Guard Bureau, had the honor of being the 2006 First Shot Speaker.

The 2006 National Matches is the 87th in an historic series of National Matches whose proud heritage looks back to the NRA "Annual Matches" that began in 1873, to the U. S. Government's creation of the "National Matches" in 1903, to the estab-

lishment of Camp Perry as the home of the National Matches in 1907, to countless champions who walked Camp Perry's hallowed ground and to tens of thousands who treasure their Camp Perry experiences.

A native of Maryland, Lieutenant General H Steven Blum currently serves as the Bureau's 25th Chief. As Chief, he is the senior uniformed National Guard officer responsible for policies, programs and plans affecting more than one-half million Army and Air National Guard personnel throughout the United States. He was appointed by President George W. Bush in January 2003, and confirmed by the U.S. Senate in April 2003. He has been a Special Forces officer throughout his career, and has commanded at every level since taking charge of a detachment in the Maryland Army National Guard's 20th Special Forces in November 1977. As NGB Chief, he serves as the Army's and Air Force's official channel of communication with the Governors and Adjutants General. Prior to his current assignment, General Blum served as Chief of Staff, United States Northern Command.



The Speakers Party for the ceremony included Major General Greg Wayt, the Adjutant General of Ohio, representing the Ohio National Guard, host of the National Matches; Ms. Judith Legerski, the Vice Chair of the CMP Board of Directors, representing the Civilian Marksmanship Program; and Mr. John Sigler, the First Vice President of the NRA, representing the National Rifle Association of America. The Honorable Chris Redfern, Member, Ohio State House of Representatives, District 80; the Honorable Robert Latta, Member, Ohio State House of Representatives, District 6, and the First Shot Speaker in 1998; Mr. Dennis Fligor, representing U. S. Senator George Voinovich; Ms. Stacey Oliver, representing U. S. Senator Mike DeWine and many other Distinguished Guests attended the Ceremony.

During the opening ceremony, General Blum emphasized how vital marksmanship is in today's fight against terrorism. He credited skilled marksmen with being one of the reasons Americans have preserved their freedom. He said the 4th of July should never be taken for granted and that we must earn the privilege of celebrating that holiday every year. General Blum thanked each of the services for their dedication, devotion and sacrifice to protect our country. Also, he thanked the many youth who were present at the ceremony for their involvement in the National Matches and noted how they are the future of the Matches and the leaders who must preserve our country's freedoms in the future.

The color guard for the First Shot Ceremony was the NJROTC Color Guard from Admiral King High School in Lorain, OH. Beth Daniels, of Toledo, Ohio, sang the National Anthem. She frequently sings the National Anthem before Toledo Mudhens and Toledo Storm games.

LTG Blum shot the traditional First Shot with an M1 Garand. The M1 Garand was the single most significant small arms development in the history of modern warfare during WWII. After the target that was 500 yards downrange exploded, General Blum posed for pictures with each of the military teams that were in attendance. # National Trophy Pistol Matches



## A Message from the DCM:

The CMP is pleased to provide these *Final Results of the 2006 National Trophy Pistol Matches*. 844 individual shooters participated in either or both the Pistol Small Arms Firing School and the National Trophy Pistol Matches. We thank all of you for your participation.

This year, entries in the President's and National Trophy Individual Pistol Matches were up three percent over 2005. Thanks to USAMU support, we successfully inaugurated the new M9 Pistol EIC Match that was fired by 303 competitors and that awarded 26 introductory 4-point legs.

This year's shooting heroes included:

- SSG James Henderson, USAR, who won his fourth President's Pistol Match. No other shooter in the 26-year history of this match has won it more than twice.
- SFC Adam Sokolowski, USAMU, who won the General Custer Trophy for the second time while holding off Steve Reiter's bid to win the National Trophy Individual Match an unprecedented three years in a row.
- GySgt Brian Zins, who won the Military Police Corps Trophy for firing the highest score in the National Trophy Team Match and who led the USMC Scarlet Team to victory in the Gold Cup Team Match. The Marines' 1133-37X score was the highest score in this match in 21 years.
- 15-year-old Rebecca Jennings, who won both junior pistol awards and was a member of the winning junior team.

The CMP extends a sincere thank you to these organizations and individuals for their significant contributions to another great National Matches:

- The Army Marksmanship Unit and coaches representing the Active and Reserve teams from the Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Air Force and Coast Guard gave us a superb Pistol Small Arms Firing School and M9 Pistol EIC Match.
- The NRA staff and range volunteers operated the ranges with efficiency, courtesy and skill.
- Erik Pierce at the National Match Armory in Rendon, Texas produced two splendid M1 Garand presentation rifles for the President's and NTI Pistol Match winners.
- Significant local area supporters included Steve Heineman of Heineman Distributors, who provided beverages for the CMP Shooter Reception, and Bill Gordon of Photomaker, who provided many excellent photos of National Matches events.
- The Ohio National Guard Camp Perry staff headed by Fort Ohio Commander COL Jim Chisman; the USAR soldiers who handled transportation, medical, signal and other duties and certainly the CMP staff who continued their tradition of dedicated service to shooters.

We sincerely hope that all of you reached your personal goals and had a great experience at the 2006 National Matches. We look forward to welcoming you back to the 2007 National Matches when we will celebrate the 100th year since the Matches first came to Camp Perry.

# National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches



The National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches are the annual U. S. national championship in service pistol and service rifle shooting. The National Trophy Matches were established by federal law in 1903, are still conducted under the statutory authority of the U. S. Code (Title 36 USC § 40725-40727) and are now governed by the Civilian Marksmanship Program. Shooters from all over the U. S., civilian and military, test their skills and compete to determine the nation's best service pistol and rifle shooters. To fulfill the CMP's statutory responsibility to "instruct citizens in marksmanship," the National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches are open to all shooters regardless of skill level. Beginners compete and learn while shooting side by side with champions. The tradition of the matches and their competitions for prestigious national trophies celebrate marksmanship excellence and provide incentives to develop individual marksmanship skills, equipment and a national competition infrastructure. The CMP National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches are held in conjunction with the NRA National Rifle and Pistol Championships through a partnership between the two organizations. The Ohio National Guard and U. S. Army Reserves also provide vital support for the matches. The CMP National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches and the NRA National Rifle and Pistol Championships are collectively known as the **NATIONAL MATCHES**.

# Inaugural M9 EIC Match a Big Success

The two-day Pistol Small Arms Firing School offers beginning shooters an excellent introduction to pistol shooting. This year it also gave students an opportunity to fire their first EIC match. This

special EIC match was patterned after military combat matches that also award 4-point “introductory” legs. It is designed to promote greater interest in service pistol shooting and proved to be very popular with school students.

On the morning of the first day of the school, USAMU Pistol Team members presented classroom instruction in the post theater. Their presentations covered equipment, fundamentals of pistol marksmanship, establishing a system, goal setting, mental and physical training and on/off range training. After the class, students received their mandatory safety briefing and had an opportunity to ask questions to a panel of pistol champions that included SFC Adam Sokolowski, SSG James Henderson, Steve Reiter, GySgt Brian Zins and an Army armorer.



Nick Pappas of Chicago, IL, won the National Matches’ first M9 EIC Match with a 283-7X total.

That afternoon, students moved onto the range where they were paired up with a military pistol team member who acted as a coach and safety officer. Each coach covered two firing points where they worked with one experienced shooter and one newcomer. The one-on-one coaching was excellent as they reinforced the morning lessons on sight alignment, trigger control and pistol shooting tactics. All students fired 35 rounds in slow, timed and rapid fire sequences.

On day two of the school, SAFS students had an opportunity to fire in the Inaugural M9 EIC Match. The new match was established as a “special EIC match” (see CMP Rules 9.1.2 and 9.7) where the top 10 percent of the competitors who are not Distinguished and who have earned no previous EIC points can win 4-point legs.

Nick Pappas, of Chicago, IL, was the top competitor who was eligible to earn EIC points in this match. Pappas is a member of the Chicago Police Department Pistol Team. He was awarded four EIC leg points that count towards earning the prestigious Distinguished Pistol Shot Badge. A total of 26 shooters including Pappas earned their first EIC points in the M9 Match.

Each student in the school received a SAFS certificate, 2006 SAFS T-shirt, USAMU Pistol Guide and an Inaugural EIC Match Pin. Special thanks goes to the U. S. Army Pistol Team and to all the military pistol coaches who dedicated their time and expertise to teaching Pistol SAFS students how to become safe, skillful pistol shooters. ## Marines Win National Trophy Team Match, Henderson and Sokolowski Win Individual Matches

Major victories in the National Trophy Pistol Matches were claimed by the Marine Corps, Army Reserve Staff Sergeant James Henderson and Army Sergeant First Class Adam Sokolowski. The Matches took place on 11-16 July as part of the National Matches at Camp Perry Ohio. The intense rivalries between the Armed Services teams and equally strong rivalries between civilian teams were once again a highlight of the matches.

The National Trophy Matches feature competitions with service rifles and pistols. In the pistol matches, competitors are required to fire either M1911 .45 cal. pistols or M9/M92 9mm pistols. Firing includes slow fire stages at 50 yards and timed and rapid fire stages at 25 yards.

This year's National Trophy Pistol Matches actually began on 11 July with a new M9 Pistol EIC Match that concluded the Pistol Small Arms Firing School. This year a modern era record of 376 students attended the school conducted by Army Marksmanship Unit instructors and coaches from other military teams. At the end of the school, everyone fired the M9 Match with military service pistols. The top ten percent of all shooters who

had not previously earned EIC credit points (count towards earning the Distinguished Badge) could earn four EIC points. Chicago policeman Nick Pappas won this new match with a 288-7X score. Pappas and 26 other shooters earned their first EIC points in this match.

The National Matches pistol phase continued with NRA championships that took place after the Pistol Small Arms Firing School and M9 Match. SSG Henderson won the NRA National Pistol Championship in a close victory over seven-time National Pistol Champion Brian Zins, U. S. Marine Corps Gunnery Sergeant. The pistol phase concluded with the National Trophy Pistol Matches on 16 July.

The first of the National Trophy Pistol Matches is the prestigious President's Pistol Match. In a tradition started by President Theodore Roosevelt, winners of this match receive a letter of congratulations from the President of the United States. The competition between two previous winners of the President's Match was especially close. Sergeant Robert Park, U. S. Army, who won this match in 2003, finished with a 387-10X total. SSG Henderson, who won this match in 1997, 2002 and 2005, was not to be outdone and finished with a 387-12X. Ties are broken

in favor of the shooter with the highest X-count. Henderson set the National Matches record for this match in 2005 with a 389-10X score and has won it more times than any other shooter in history.

The President's Match has always been popular with service pistol shooters because the top 100 competitors are named to the "President's Hundred." Every member of the Hundred receives a certificate and medallion; military shooters can wear President's Hundred tabs on their uniforms. Special notoriety is attached to placing 100th and 101st in this

match. This year, Ashleigh Grosshuesch from Sheboygan, Wisconsin was 100th, just making the Hundred, and CMDR George Bratton, USNR, was 101st, just missing the cut.

In the National Trophy Individual Pistol Match where the Custer Trophy is at stake, former Army Reserve and now civilian shooter Steve Reiter from Tucson, Arizona was going for an unprecedented three in a row, having won this match in 2004 and 2005. This year he posted another excellent score, 288-12X. Reiter's score topped the early leaderboards, but was bumped back to second when later scores came in and an outstanding 292-9X total was posted by SFC Adam Sokolowski, a member of the U. S. Army Pistol Team. Sokolowski previously won the Custer Trophy as an Army Private in 1999.

The National Trophy Pistol Match is a high pressure match for many shooters because civilians can earn 10 EIC credit points that count towards the 30 they need to earn for the Distinguished Pistol Shot Badge. 31 Non-Distinguished shooters received EIC credit points in the match; six of those shooters ended with 30 or more EIC points and have now earned their Distinguished Pistol Shot Badges. They are:

- ⊙ Robert Case, Vacaville, CA
- ⊙ Haig Derderian, Racine, WI
- ⊙ Keith Heinauer, Whispering Pines, NC
- ⊙ Jon Milan, Phoenix, AZ
- ⊙ Patrick Powell, Columbia, TN
- ⊙ Ashliegh Grosshuesch, Sheboygan, WI

Grosshuesch had the unique distinction of not only being the 100th place shooter in the President's Hundred, but he was also the 31st Non-Distinguished shooter among the 31 who earned EIC credits.

For the last few years, the National Trophy Team Match has been a battle between Army, Army Reserve and Marine Corps Teams. Last year the Marine Corps won over the Army and USAR Team in a relatively close contest where they were just three points ahead of the Army team and nine points ahead of the USAR. This year the Marines increased their winning score from 1114 to 1133 and had an 11-point victory margin over the second place Army team. The Marine Team was led by GySgt Brian Zins who fired the highest overall score in the team match with a 292-11X.

Civilian teams compete under different rules than the military teams. Civilian teams are limited to residents of the state the team represents. The Oglethorpe Trophy is awarded to the winning state or club team. The Penn-

sylvania Rifle and Pistol Association Team won a narrow 1085 to 1084 victory over the Virginia State Team to take this highly coveted trophy.

The National Trophy Pistol Matches also feature special junior events where competitors fire .22 caliber pistols over the same courses as the President's and National Trophy Individual Matches. The leading junior was 15-year-old Rebecca Jennings from Boerne, Texas. Jennings was the high junior in the President's Match with a 356-3X, won the National Junior Pistol Trophy with a 263-5X and was a member of the Texas State Rifle Association Junior Gold team that won the National Junior Pistol Team Trophy.

Altogether, 21 different National Trophies were awarded to the outstanding competitors in the matches. A total of 843 individuals participated in the 2006 National Trophy Pistol Matches and Pistol Small Arms Firing School. Overall school attendance was up 14 percent over the previous year while the match events all showed increases over 2005 tallies.
