The Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) Talladega Marksmanship Park invites you to participate in its **1000 Aggregate Match** on Saturday, 1 April 2017 & **EIC Rifle Match** on Sunday, 2 April 2017. These matches are open to the public; new or experience shooters are welcome.

CMP TALLADEGA MARKSMANSHIP PARK:



The CMP began planning construction of the new Talladega Marksmanship Park in 2012 and completed the installation of electronic targets on the range in 2015. The Park has a 13,000 sq. foot Club House with classrooms, offices, and ADA compliant restrooms. Containing over 500 acres of the finest public facilities in the nation, competition and practice take place on state of the art electronic targets that allow participants and spectators to view groups and scoring via electronic monitors. Sporting clays, 5-stand, and trap are shot using swipe card technology – utilizing fully automated trap machines.

KONGSBERG ELECTRONIC TARGETS:

All firing will be completed on Kongsberg Electronic Targets (KTS). The KTS system, installed at each 200, 300, and 600 yard line registers each shot and relays the location and score value to a monitor beside each shooter on the firing line. The targets down range will raise and lower for the desired distance from behind the firing line. All target operations, including final scoring, will be controlled from a range center command booth.

COMPETITION EVENTS:

1000 point aggregate:

2 sighters + 20 shots at 200 yards standing in 22 minutes

2 sighters + 20 shots at 200 yards sitting rapid fire in 60 seconds (per 10 rd. string)

2 sighters + 20 shots at 300 yards prone rapid fire in 70 seconds (per 10 rd. string)

2 sighters + 20 shots at 600 yards prone slow fire in 22 minutes

2 sighters + 20 shots at 600 yards prone slow fire in 22 minutes

Entry fee for this match is \$40 for open competitors and \$30 for junior competitors

EIC Rifle:

10 shots at 200 yards standing slow fire in 10 minutes

10 shots at 200 yards sitting rapid fire in 60 seconds

10 shots at 300 yards prone rapid fire in 70 seconds

20 shots at 600 yards prone slow fire in 20 minutes

Entry fee for this match is \$30 for open competitors and \$25 for junior competitors

SANCTIONING & RULES:

These matches will be governed by the current CMP Competition Rules. Copies of the rules may be downloaded from the Civilian Marksmanship Program website at <http://thecmp.org/competitions/cmp-competitions-rulebooks/>.

An updated appendix for electronic target scoring is also available on this website for clarification.

SQUADDING:

Please indicate on your registration the relay on which you would *prefer* to fire. We will try to honor squadding requests, but relays will be filled in the order that entries are received. There will be two relays for this match; the first relay will fire while the second relay verifies scores, and then the relays will switch.

SAFETY:

The use of ECI's in all rifles and pistols is required at the CMP Talladega Marksmanship Park. The ECI is a brightly colored safety flag that is inserted into the chamber of the firearm. ECI's provide visual confirmation that firearms are unloaded. ECI's must be inserted after rifles are uncased and when not firing or in preparation period. ECI's will be available on the range for those that do not have them.

A CMP Range Safety Card is mandatory to fire on the CMP Talladega Range. Range Safety Cards are received after taking the safety class at the CMP Park Club House

and expire after one year. Range safety classes and videos will be available, as needed, to competitors needing or renewing their Range Safety Cards.

SCORE POSTING:

All scores fired will be displayed in the CMP Competitor Tracker results system at www.thecmp.org as soon as the electronic targets score them. Scores and competitor rankings will be displayed in the Club House throughout the competition. Preliminary and final printed results bulletins will be posted in the Club House.

AWARDS:

CMP medals will be awarded in the match rifle and service rifle category for up to three places:

- 4 competitors: 1st place
- 5 to 9 competitors: 2nd place
- 10 or more competitors: 3rd place

A portion of the entry fee will also be distributed back as cash prizes.

HOW TO REGISTER:

Competitors who are age 18 or older must complete and sign a notarized CMP Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement. This can be completed prior to arrival or it may be signed at the Marksmanship Center (a notary will be available). You can print the adult liability release form by going to
