The Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) Talladega Marksmanship Park invites you to participate in its 2017 **EIC Pistol and .22 EIC Matches** on 1 April and 7 October. These matches are open to the public; new or experience shooters are welcome.

There will also be EIC Pistol and .22 EIC Pistol matches at the 2-4 June 2017 D-Day match and 5-10 December 2017 Talladega 600 match.

CMP TALLADEGA MARKSMANSHIP PARK:



The CMP began planning construction of the new Talladega Marksmanship Park in 2012 and completed the installation of electronic targets on the range in 2015. The Park has a 13,000 sq. foot Club House with classrooms, offices, and ADA compliant restrooms. Containing over 500 acres of the finest public facilities in the nation, competition and practice take place on state of the art electronic targets that allow participants and spectators to view groups and scoring via electronic monitors. Sporting clays, 5-stand, and trap are shot using swipe card technology – utilizing fully automated trap machines.

KONGSBERG ELECTRONIC TARGETS:

All firing will be completed on Kongsberg Electronic Targets (KTS). The KTS system, installed at each 25 and 50 yard line registers each shot and relays the location and score value to a monitor beside each shooter on the firing line. The targets down range will raise and lower for the desired distance from behind the firing line. All target operations, including final scoring, will be controlled from a range center command booth.

COMPETITION EVENTS:

Competition course for both the EIC and .22 EIC match is the National Match Pistol Course;

10 shots, slow fire, at 50 yards, 10 minutes
2 series of 5 shots, timed fire, at 25 yards, 20 seconds per series
2 series of 5 shots, rapid fire, at 25 yards, 10 seconds per series

This a no sighter match.

The entry fee for this match will be \$25 for open competitors and \$20 for junior competitors, per match.

SANCTIONING & RULES:

The competition will be governed by ***CMP COMPETITION RULES FOR SERVICE RIFLE AND PISTOL*** 20th Edition - 2016. Copies of the rules may be downloaded from the CMP website at <http://thecmp.org/competitions/cmp-competitions-rulebooks/>.

An updated appendix for electronic target scoring is also available on this website for clarification.

SQUADDING:

All shooters will fire the .22 EIC course first, followed by the EIC pistol course. Lane assignments will be randomly squadded upon check-in.

SAFETY:

The use of ECI's in all rifles and pistols is required at the CMP Talladega Marksmanship Park. The ECI is a brightly colored safety flag that is inserted into the chamber of the firearm. ECI's provide visual confirmation that firearms are unloaded. ECI's must be inserted after rifles are uncased and when not firing or in preparation period. ECI's will be available on the range for those that do not have them.

HOW TO REGISTER:

Register by calling the Talladega Marksmanship Park at 256-474-4408 or cmptalladega@thecmp.org. The match fee is \$20 per competitor, per match. Payment can be made online, or will be taken at the Marksmanship Park upon check in.

Competitors who are age 18 or older must complete and sign a notarized CMP Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement. This can be completed prior to arrival or it may be signed at the Marksmanship Center (a notary will be available). You can print the adult liability release form by going to <http://www.theCMP.org/Competitions/Forms/Affidavit.pdf>. Competitors under the age of 18 must provide a Parent Consent Form completed upon arrival. You can print the Junior Liability Release by going to http://www.theCMP.org/Competitions/Forms/Jr_Release.pdf. All competitors must be 10 years or older to fire at the Marksmanship Park.

Forms may be brought to Talladega but please pre-register for this event.

DIRECTIONS TO RANGE:

The Talladega Marksmanship Park is located approximately 5 miles behind the Talladega Superspeedway race track.

From I-20 East (Atlanta)

Take exit 173 South off I-20
Follow Speedway Blvd to Allen Rd
Turn South (left) on Allen Rd
Turn right onto Jackson Trace Rd
Turn East (left) onto Turner Mill Rd
The Marksmanship Park will be on the South (left) of the road.

From I-20 West (Birmingham)

Take exit 168 South off I-20
Turn East (left) onto Speedway Blvd
Turn South (left) on Allen Rd
Turn right onto Jackson Trace Rd
Turn East (left) onto Turner Mill Rd
The Marksmanship Park will be on the South (left) of the road.
