

**Equipment. Air Pistols/Precision Air Rifles.**

Shooters who fire in the air pistol and air rifle events may bring their own competition air pistols or air rifles that shoot 600 fps or less. Please bring your own pistol fill adapters. The CMP offers a small selection of air rifles and air pistols for rent for a fee of \$5.00.

**AiR-15 Match Rifle.** The CMP has these rifles and uppers on hand during the National Match Air Rifle Events. Shooters who wish to “rent” one of these rifles to fire in the 20-shot standing air rifle re-entry may do so for \$5.00 per day.

**Shooting Equipment.** Shooting clothing and equipment used in each event must comply with the rules for each event. Spotting scopes are not required since all shots are indicated on individual monitors at each firing point. Shooting mats are available at the range.

**Air and CO<sub>2</sub>.** Compressed air and CO<sub>2</sub> is available at the range for anyone who needs to fill cylinders. Please bring your own pistol fill adapters.

**How to Enter.** Entries in all National Match Air Rifle Events may be made the day of the match and welcome anytime the range is open (see schedule). Entry fees are also paid at that time.

## Events Available During All Phases:

27 June – 29 July

### 20 Shot Standing Re-Entry Match

**\$5.00 per entry—unlimited re-entry permitted**

#### Rifle Classes: Match, Sporter & AR-Type

The event will be separated into three rifle classes, Sporter, Match and AR-Type Rifles. Shooters will fire 20 record shots in the Standing position on a 200 yard reduced SR target. Shooters who enter this match in the **SPORTER** will also be entered into a “Top Center Shot” match. The CMP will take the best shot fired during the 20 shot string and calculate the distance to the center of the target. \$2.00 of every entry fee goes into the Top Center Shot prize pool for this match.

### 30 Shot Air Rifle Re-Entry Bench Match

**\$5.00 per entry—unlimited re-entry permitted**

#### Rifle Classes: Match, Sporter & AR-Type

The course of fire is unlimited sighting shots and 30 record shots on the ISSF air rifle target. This match is for sporter (no extra charge), precision and AR-Type air rifles (\$5.00 rental fee). No scopes allowed. Supports provided by the range must be used. Overall top award medals will be awarded at the end for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> places.

### Open Practice Shooting

**\$5.00 per practice session**

There will be a few firing points set aside for open practice. Please feel welcome to come in to the range for additional practice. See CMP Marksmanship Center Range Schedule for Open Practice Shooting hours.

## Events Available During Pistol Phase:

30 June – 13 July

### 30 Shot Air Pistol Re-Entry Match

**\$5.00 per entry—unlimited re-entry permitted**

Competitors may bring their own air pistols. The course of fire is unlimited sighting shots and 30 record shots on the ISSF Air Pistol target. Shooters who enter this match will also be entered into a “Top Center Shot” match. The CMP will take the best shot fired during the 30 shot string and calculate the distance to the center of the target. Air pistols will be available for rent. Competitors are invited to shoot the event as many times as they wish. \$2.00 of every entry fee goes into the Top Center Shot prize pool for this match.

### 60 Shot Air Pistol Championship

**\$10 per entry fee—one entry per competitor**

This is a one-time event that may be fired any time the range is open two hours prior to closing. Shooters will have 1 hour, 45 minutes, to shoot unlimited sighters and 60 record shots on the ISSF air pistol target.

### AiR – 15 Top 20 Shoulder-to-Shoulder Super Final 22 July at 2:00 PM

**\$10.00 per entry—unlimited re-entry (includes rifle rental)**

#### 1 Rifle Class: AR-Type

The AiR – 15 Challenge is a 20 shot re-entry match using the AiR – 15 air rifle. Shooters will fire 20 record shots on the SR reduced target. The TOP 20 individuals from the re-entry match will be invited to fire in the AiR – 15 Challenge Shoulder to Shoulder Super Final on 30 July at 2:00 PM. During the Shoulder to Shoulder competition, each shooter will be given an 8 minute sighting period, followed by 10 record shots in 10 minutes and multiple 3-shot series and single shots eliminating to first place. Prize money will be distributed based on the number of event entries. 75% of all entry money will be distributed as prize money. **20 Shot Standing Re-Entry Match** – 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> overall place will be receive medals. Pins Cut Scores:

**60 Shot Air Pistol Championship** – Special National Matches Air Gun Championship Awards will be presented to the Overall Winner, the High Woman, High Senior and High Junior in this event. Medallions with neck ribbons cut scores:

Gold: 555 – 600 Silver: 545 – 554 Bronze: 530 – 544

**Top Center Shot Cash Prizes.** Shooters who compete in the 20 Shot Standing and 30 Shot Air Pistol re-entry matches are automatically entered in a “Top Center Shot” Match for those events. \$2.00 of each \$5.00 entry in re-entry matches will be placed in a cash pool for that event. The best center shot fired in each re-entry event will be selected and checked. The CMP will take the highest shot values and calculate the distance of those shots from the target center (measured in 1/100th of a millimeter). A Leaderboard showing the current best eight center shots in each event will be posted at the range. At the end of the competition, checks will be distributed to the eight competitors in each event who have the best Top Center Shots. The prize money will be based on the percentages of the total cash pool in each event.

1st place – 25%	5th place – 10%
2nd place – 20%	6th place - 10%
3rd place – 15%	7th place – 5%
4th place – 10%	8th place – 5%
