

## **CMP SMALLBORE**



**General Information:** After a successful premier in 2018, the CMP is excited for the return of Smallbore to Camp Perry, OH in 2019. Based on the feedback received from you, the shooter, the CMP has added events to the schedule. The overwhelming majority of the feedback revolved around Prone. You asked for a 6400 and you got it. Along with the with changes to the Prone Championship, the CMP has purchased new smallbore rifles for a newly developed Smallbore Small Arms Firing School (SAFS). The goal of the SAFS class is to provide new opportunities to junior shooters in an effort to grow the smallbore shooting community. The SAFS class will be instructed by the renowned US Army Marksmanship Unit. A new junior team match has also been added to the 3-Position Championship. The CMP looks forward to seeing you return to Camp Perry this summer!

**Dates:** 16 – 24 July, 2019

**Camp Perry Check-In & In-Processing:** When competitors arrive at Camp Perry, all must first go to the National Matches Welcome Center (In-Processing) in Building #3. The check-process for competitors and Team Officials includes: 1) complete or provide a Post Locator Form for emergency contacts, 2) sign or provide an Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Form or confirm that you have previously signed one of these forms (Juniors under 18 must provide a signed Parental Consent Form), 3) confirm your event entry data, 4) receive your competitor labels, 5) receive your squadding information, 6) receive your National Matches Program and Welcome Packet, 7) receive a wrist band confirming you have completed In-Processing. Notaries will be on duty at the National Matches Welcome Center to notarize Eligibility Affidavits.

**Rules:** 2019 CMP Competition Rules for Smallbore Rifle

**Scoring:** In 2018, the CMP partnered with Shooter's Technology to revolutionize the way paper targets are scored, utilizing Orion Scoring System and mobile devices. At the conclusion of each stage of fire, CMP Range Officers will photograph the targets after firing. The target images will be sent to the Orion Scoring System and scored by CMP Staff. All targets will be collected by CMP Range Officers. When scoring is complete, scores will be uploaded to CMP's Club and Competition Tracker. New to 2019, all athletes will be able to download the Orion Results Application for Apple and Android devices. Athletes will need to create a free account with Orion. The Orion app will allow athletes to see match information and results, receive score notifications when their targets are scored and receive graphical score cards of their targets.

All targets will be taken to the Gary Anderson CMP Competition Center at the conclusion of firing. Athletes will be able to review their targets before scores are final. All final results will be posted to the CMP Club and Competition Tracker.

## **SMALL ARMS FIRING SCHOOL (SAFS)**

**General Information:** For over a century, the Small Arms Firing School has been an instrumental source for individuals to delve into firearm safety and competition technique. Until now, this class has only been offered in both Service Rifle and Service Pistol. New to 2019, the CMP and US Army Marksmanship Unit are excited to offer a new SAFS class designed to introduce athletes to competitive smallbore shooting. The CMP has purchased new smallbore rifles to be used in the class. This class is currently offered to junior shooters who have an interest to learn about smallbore competition. Personal smallbore rifles will not be allowed in the class. Students will check in at CMP's In-Processing. Class will begin at the Gary Anderson CMP Competition Center at 8:00 am. Students will move to Petrarca Range, where they will be issued a rifle and ammunition.

**What will be provided:** Smallbore rifles and Ammunition will be provided to each student.

**Equipment you should bring:** Personal shooting coats/pants, boots, slings, spotting scopes, gloves, hearing protection, etc. Students should also plan to bring water and lunch.

**Entry Fee:** \$35

## **RIFLE RENTAL**

**General Information:** The smallbore rifles used in the Small Arms Firing School will be made available to the students and general public to use during the 2019 Smallbore National Matches. ## **THREE-POSITION NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP**

**General Information:** The Three-Position National Championship will consist of two days of 3x40 competitions. On Wednesday July 17th, competitors will be required to use metallic sights (Rule 5.2.1). On Thursday July 18th, competitors are permitted to use any sight under Rule 5.2. There will be an Elimination Final (Rule 6.6.2) on July 18<sup>th</sup> for the top eight (8) Open and Junior competitors, based on the two-day aggregate.

**Dates-Time:** July 17 & 18, Firing will begin at 8:00AM both days (2 relays)

**Entry Fee:** \$90 Open, \$75 Juniors

**Course of Fire:** The three-position course of fire (Rule 6.6) is fired at 50 Meters, in Kneeling, Prone and Standing. The number of shots and time limits are found in the table below. On Thursday, July 18, two Finals will be conducted for the Top-8 Open and Junior competitors respectively. The Finals will take place on Petrarca Range, on the CMP's KTS Target System. The Three-Position Final will be an elimination final run in accordance to rule 6.6.2.

### ***THREE-POSITION JUNIOR TEAM NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP – Freedoms Fire***

**General Information:** The Three-Position Junior Team Championship is a two-person team match, that will be held on July 19. The two team members will fire simultaneously. Each team must provide a coach, that may be on the firing line with the team.

**Date-Time:** July 19, Firing will begin at 8:00AM

**Entry Fee:** \$50 per Junior Team

**Course of Fire:** Each team member will fire a 3x20 at a distance of 50 meters. Each team will be assigned two firing points. At the conclusion of each stage of fire, the team members or team representative will go downrange and replace the targets for the next stage.

**Team Composition:** Teams must be made up of two team members and may have one non-firing coach. Teams may designate Junior State Association or Junior Club. At-Large Junior teams are permitted.

**Registration:** Team cards must be picked up and paid for at Camp Perry Check-in and In-Processing (Center doors of Building #3).

### ***THREE-POSITION TEAM NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP***

**General Information:** The three-position team match is designed to give shooters the opportunity to compete side-by-side with club members, family and friends. The event will give team members an opportunity to coach their teammates as two members will fire at a time.

**Dates-Time:** July 19, Firing will begin at 10:30AM (following Junior Team Match)

**Entry Fee:** \$100 Open Teams, \$80 Junior Teams

**Course of Fire:** Each member of the four-person team fires the 3x20 course of fire. At least two team members from each team must fire with metallic sights. Firing is conducted at 50 meters in the Kneeling, Prone and Standing positions. Each team will be assigned two firing points. Two team members will fire simultaneously, with the additional two members firing immediately after the completion of each stage of fire (position). A target change will be conducted between the pairs of shooters. All four team members and one coach can be present on the firing line while firing is conducted.

**Team Composition:** Teams must be made up of four team members and may have one non-firing coach. Teams may designate Club, State Association, Junior Club and Junior State Association Teams. At-Large and At-Large Junior teams are permitted.

**Registration:** Team cards must be picked up and paid for at Camp Perry Check-in and In-Processing (Center doors of Building #3).

### **PRONE IRON SIGHT NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP**

**General Information:** The Prone Iron Sight National Championship will consist of two days of Prone competition. Competitors will be required to use metallic sights (Rule 5.2.1).

**Dates-Time:** July 20 & 21 (3200), Firing will begin at 8:00AM each day

**Entry Fee: \$90 Open, \$75 Juniors**

**Course of Fire:** The course of fire will consist of two days of competition. Each day will consist of four stages of fire following the chart below.

### **PRONE ANY SIGHT NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP**

**General Information:** The Prone Any Sight National Championship will consist of two days of Prone competition. Competitors will be permitted to use any sights as approved by Rule 5.2.

**Dates-Time:** July 23 & 24 (3200), Firing will begin at 8:00AM each day

**Entry Fee: \$90 Open, \$75 Juniors**

**Course of Fire:** The course of fire will consist of two days of competition. Each day will consist of four stages of fire as described in the CMP Smallbore Prone (1600) chart above.

### **PRONE ELIMINATION MATCH**

**General Information:** The Prone Elimination Match is an innovative match designed to provide a new level of excitement to the National Matches. The Top 75 individual athletes from the Prone Any Sight Championship, will qualify to participate in the Prone Elimination Match. Athletes will fire at least one stage of fire. Based on the scores from the first stage, the Top 25 athletes will advance to the second stage. The Top 10 athletes from the second stage will advance to the final round. The final stage will be shot on Petrarca Range, on CMP KTS Electronic Targets. There will be an elimination final as described in rule 6.6.5.

**Date-Time:** July 22, Firing will begin at 8:00AM

**Entry Fee:** Free to those who qualify!

**Course of Fire:** The Top-75 athletes will all fire a Dewar course. The targets will then be scored, and the results will be posted. The Top 25 athletes from the first stage will advance to the second stage, where athletes will fire 40 shots at 100 yards. Scores from the second stage will be used to determine the Top 10 athletes, that will move on to the final stage. The Top 10 athletes will then move to Petrarca Range, where an Elimination Final will be conducted as prescribed in rule 6.6.5 until a Champion is crowned.

### **PRONE NATIONAL TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP**

**General Information:** The prone team match is designed to give shooters the opportunity to compete side-by-side with club members, family and friends. The event will give team members an opportunity to coach their teammates as two members will fire at a time.

**Dates-Time:** July 22, Firing will begin at 12:00PM

**Entry Fee: \$100 Open Teams, \$80 Junior Teams**

**Course of Fire:** Each member of the four-person team fires a Dewar match. At least two team members from each team must fire with metallic sights. Each team will be assigned two firing points. Two team members will fire simultaneously, with the additional two members firing immediately after the completion of each yard line. A target change will be conducted between the pairs of shooters. All four team members and one coach can be present on the firing line while firing is conducted.

**Team Composition:** Teams must be made up of four team members and may have one non-firing coach. Teams may designate Club, State Association, Junior Club and Junior State Association Teams. At-Large and At-Large Junior teams are permitted.

**Registration:** Team cards must be picked up and paid for at Camp Perry Check-in and In-Processing (Center doors of Building #3).

**Awards:**

National Champions: Both Open and Junior National Champions will be recognized for 3-Position and Prone.

Classification awards, daily stage awards and aggregate stage awards will be recognized. Individual categories awards for daily stages and aggregates in the Senior, Junior, Intermediate Junior and Sub-Junior will be given. Team categories will be recognized (At-Large, At-Large Junior, State Association, Junior State Association, Club and Junior Club). Individual categories and classifications must have at least five competitors for first place to be awarded, ten for second and fifteen for third. Team categories must have at least three teams for first place, and five or more for first through third. For some categories, the high competitor/team may only be recognized. Additional prizes and awards may be awarded.

High category and classification award winners in the daily aggregate matches will be recognized at the awards ceremony. The top eight (8) competitors in 3P and the top ten (10) competitors in Prone will be recognized at the ceremony. In the aggregate matches, first through third juniors in each junior category and high senior will be recognized. All other prizes may be picked up at the front desk of CMP Headquarters. All award money will be mailed.

Any person who receives a monetary prize will be required to complete a W9 form prior to leaving Camp Perry. W9 forms can be submitted electronically or turned in to CMP staff at In-Processing. Blank W9 forms will be available at In-Processing.
