The Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) Talladega Marksmanship Park invites you to participate in its **Talladega High Power CMP Cup Match** on **Thursday-Sunday, 20-23 June 2019**. This match is open to the public; new or experience shooters are welcome. This CMP Regional Cup Match offers three 1000 Point aggregates, a 2-person team and an EIC Rifle match.

CMP TALLADEGA MARKSMANSHIP PARK:



The CMP began planning construction of the new Talladega Marksmanship Park in 2012 and completed the installation of electronic targets on the range in 2015. The Park has a 13,000 sq. foot Club House with classrooms, offices, and ADA compliant restrooms. Containing over 500 acres of the finest public facilities in the nation,

competition and practice take place on state of the art electronic targets that allow participants and spectators to view groups and scoring via electronic monitors. Sporting clays, 5-stand, and trap are shot using swipe card technology – utilizing fully automated trap machines.

SAFETY RULES:

The use of ECI's (Empty Chamber Indicators) in all rifle and pistols is required at the CMP Talladega Marksmanship Park. ECI's must be inserted after rifles are uncased and when not firing or in preparation period. ECI's will be available on the range for those that do not have them.

Range Safety Briefing-

A CMP range safety card is mandatory to fire on the CMP Talladega range. Range safety cards are received after taking the safety class at the CMP Park Club House. Classes will be held every morning before the relays begin firing.

- ⊙ 2 sighters & 10 record shots, 200 yards, rapid fire
- ⊙ 2 sighters & 10 record shots, 300 yards, rapid fire
- ⊙ 2 sighters & 20 record shots, 600 yards, slow fire prone

Entry fee into this match is \$40 per team/\$25 per Junior Team

AWARDS:

The winner of the 3000 Point aggregate will be our CMP Cup Champions and will be awarded medals and/or plaques. A Portion of the entry fees will be distributed back as cash prizes for each match. The Overall Match Rifle & Service Winner will be awarded .50cents per point of their 3-day average, providing there are 10 or more competitors competing in each rifle category.

High Overall Woman

There must be 5 or more competitors in the category for an award to be given.

SANCTIONING & RULES:

Service and Match rifles are allowed.

SQUADDING:

For each relay, 50 targets will be used. There will be two relays for these matches, with the except of the team match. The first relay will fire while the second relay verifies scores, and then the relays will switch.

SCORE POSTING:

All scores fired will be displayed in the CMP Competitor Tracker results system at www.thecmp.org as soon as the electronic targets score them. Scores and competitor rankings will be displayed in the Club House throughout the competition. Preliminary and final printed results bulletins will be posted in the Club House.

DIRECTIONS TO RANGE:

The Talladega Marksmanship Park is located approximately 5 miles behind the Talladega Superspeedway race track.

From I-20 East (Atlanta)

Take exit 173 South off I-20

Follow Speedway Blvd to Allen Rd

Turn South (left) on Allen Rd

Turn right onto Jackson Trace Rd

Turn East (left) onto Turner Mill Rd

The Marksmanship Park will be on the South (left) of the road.

From I-20 West (Birmingham)

Take exit 168 South off I-20

Turn East (left) onto Speedway Blvd

Turn South (left) on Allen Rd

Turn right onto Jackson Trace Rd
