# Individual and Team Matches

**TRIGGER WEIGHING/SAFETY CHECKS:** All firearms, to be used in any CMP Games or CMP Service Rifle events (Match Rifles Not Included), are **required** to be inspected by a CMP sanctioned armorer prior to any live fire at every event. Competitors will be required to present all applicable scorecards to the CMP Armorer in order to complete the inspection process. To expedite the inspection process, competitors are requested to apply their competitor label to each score card. Please include the last **four** digits of the serial number for the firearm to be used under the CMP Competitor Label Box. Upon completion of the firearm inspection process, each scorecard will receive a stamp of approval from the CMP Armorer, indicating that no safety violations or rules compliance issues were **observed** at the time of inspection. Each rifle will also receive an inspection tag, verifying participation in the inspection process. Any inspection tags from prior events are to be removed at the time of inspection.

Upon conclusion of firing, any scorecard received by CMP staff which **does not bear** the CMP Armorer's stamp, will be entered as "**Out-of-Competition**". To accommodate unforeseeable circumstances, competitors will receive a 30 minute window after completion of firing in which a fired rifle may still be inspected.

This enhanced inspection process will aid in ensuring match compliance, as well as promote the safest experience that CMP can provide for all participants on our firing line. Please be advised that CMP Armorer's are operating in an advisory role and **cannot absolutely certify** the safety or compliance of all firearms in the time provided. It is still the responsibility of each competitor to ensure compliance with all CMP mandated safety regulations and match rules. The Armorer's stamp will not serve as an alibi in

the event that a violation is found before, during, or after participation in a match.

**SCORER'S DUTIES:** Competitors are reminded that you will be required to perform duties as scorers in accordance with CMP Highpower Rifle Competition Rule 3.4.3. **You are the KEY person who must be able to validate the actions of the competitor you are scoring.** Be alert for possible safety violations. Do not allow the competitor to leave the line with an unsafe rifle or cause an unsafe condition. Use of the Empty Chamber Indicator is required by rule 3.6.1. **The scorer is responsible for turning in the scorecard after it is signed by the scorer and competitor.**

**TARGET PULLING DUTIES:** Competitors are reminded that they are also responsible for performing target pulling duties in accordance with CMP Highpower Rifle Competition 3.4. Competitors with approved special medical authorizations who cannot pull targets must provide substitute target pullers in accordance with Rule 2.5.2(c). When fulfilling target pulling duties, competitors serve as competition officials who are responsible for accurately and quickly scoring and signaling the scores of shots fired by competitors.

**SQUADED SERVICE RIFLE PRACTICE FOR SAFS COACHES.** All coaches in the Rifle SAFS will fire their squadded service rifle practice on Viale Range immediately after the M16 Rifle EIC Match concludes. The course of fire will be the same as the open squadded service rifle practice (10 minutes at 300 yards and 10 minutes at 600 yards).

**SUNDAY, JULY 26, RODRIGUEZ RANGE**  
**SQUADED PRACTICE**

Competitors who would like to shoot the practice at 1100 may pick up a squadding ticket at the CMP Competitions Center (600 yard line) on Rodriguez Range beginning at 1000 hours. Five relays will be squadded. After all squadding tickets are issued one random relay will be chosen not to perform pit duty. That random relay will be announced on the line after all squadding is issued. Space is limited to first come, first serve. We cannot guarantee that you will receive a firing point.

1030 Competitor shuttles begin running initially from the paved parking lot area to the 300 yard line on Rodriguez Range. Two relays will fire first and two relays will report to the pits

1100 Commence fire. This is a voluntary practice. **Competitors MUST furnish their own ammunition. DO NOT USE ANY SCORE CARDS!** The course of fire will be 10 minutes slow-fire prone at the 300-yard line followed by 10 minutes of slow-fire prone at the 600-yard line. Shooters may fire as many rounds as they wish within these time limits.
