Attention All Junior Rifle Shooters!

The CMP is pleased to announce that its annual CMP National Matches Junior Rifle Camp will be held on Wednesday July 17 through Monday July 22, 2018, at Petrarca and the Gary Anderson CMP Competition Center, Camp Perry Ohio.

CAMP PROGRAM AND OBJECTIVES

All smallbore & air rifle camp students will receive expert coaching in the fundamental principles and techniques of 3-position and 4-position smallbore and International air rifle shooting. Students will be provided a safe, enjoyable learning experience that will significantly contribute to improving their shooting skills.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

The camp has been primarily designed for the intermediate shooter, and will be held using both smallbore and air rifles. Students must supply their own smallbore rifle. Students are encouraged to bring their own air rifle – but the CMP will lend sporter rifles to campers who do not have one to bring.

APPLICANTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO APPLY AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

Camp is designed for junior shooters age 12-20 who have fired in smallbore and air rifle competitions. All junior shooting competitors are welcome. To allow us to provide your best learning experience, list location and type of match, date and score fired (upload a highlighted results to nmcampheadcoach@gmail.com). Applicants need to submit a 2019 Sectional Score, 3 Position or 4 Position Smallbore or a USA JORC Smallbore Score, CMP 3P Air Rifle Score. Other scores will be accepted after 01 April 2019. Admission is open 03 March. Camp reserves the right to limit each state to the first 15 applicants. All applications received will be used to fill camp after 01 April 2019.

ADULT SPONSORSHIP:

Students who have not reached their 18th Birthday by July 17, 2019, must be accompanied to Camp Perry by an adult sponsor (age 21 or older). An adult may not sponsor more than three junior students.

LIMITED ENROLLMENT: Enrollment will be limited to 71 students.

REGISTRATION AND FEES

Registration and fees for camp will be accepted at CMP Headquarters on a first-come, first-served basis. Registration fees cover all administrative costs and training materials. (The registration fees do not cover costs such as travel, room and board.)

- Advanced Registration: The fee for advanced registration is \$250.00 per student, and must be received with registration forms by the CMP no later than May 01, 2019.
- Standard Registration: The fee for standard registration is \$275.00 per student. This fee will be charged for students whose registration materials are received after May 01, 2019.
- Cancellation requests may be submitted by mail, email or phone. Cancellations received at least 30 days prior to camp will receive a full refund. Cancellation requests received between 20 days and one day prior to camp receive a 50% refund of all fees paid, no-shows on the day camp starts will not receive a refund unless the cancellation is caused by bereavement, a medical emergency or CMP Error. The CMP Cancellation policy is designed to discourage no-shows and to encourage campers who know they will not be able to fill their entry slots to report cancellations as soon as possible. No refund will be given if camp is cancelled due to inclement weather.

All required entry forms for the CMP NM Jr Camp consist of:

- CMP Medical Release and Parent Consent Form
- Shooters over 18 - CMP Release of Liability – (this form must be notarized)
- Jr. Sectional scores or recent match score records
- Classification Card
- Special Power of Attorney Form (for campers with sponsor other than parent). This form must be notarized – and retained by/with the campers sponsor so they may care for the camper.
- Required and Optional Equipment Form
- Lodging Information

You have not reserved an acceptance to camp until the required forms have been submitted to nmcampheadcoach@gmail.com. Students should review all entry forms with their parents prior to submission.

The CMP will acknowledge all students' entries in writing, and Camp Perry Reporting information will be sent to each student with the acknowledgement letter.

OTHER COSTS:

Students are required to cover the cost of their room and board, plus all other incidental and personal expenses. Hut lodging arrangement must be handled directly with the Camp Perry Clubhouse Rental Office.

CANCELLATION OF CAMP:

The CMP reserves the right to cancel the smallbore rifle camp if a minimum of 50 students have not registered by June 01, 2019. Cancellation notifications will be mailed and emailed to each registrant if the camp is cancelled.

STAFF QUALIFICATIONS:

All instruction and coaching will be conducted by outstanding official Certified Coaches, including members of the National Coach Development Staff.

Camp Activities for 2019 will be divided between 50 & 100 yd. smallbore rifle shooting on Petrarca Range, Camp Perry, and 10 meter Air Rifle shooting on the Gary Anderson CMP Competition Center. All campers will spend time at both ranges. Shooters will practice and compete in both smallbore and air rifle. Camp direction is to give shooters the boost required to improve scores that may lead to collegiate shooting. Both Smallbore & International Standing Air Rifle are priorities but all campers will attempt some 3P air practice or matches as well.
