



Junior Olympic 3PAR State Championships

Guidelines for 2018



The State Junior Olympic 3PAR Championships will be held between 1February – 1May 2018. Athletes will qualify for the 2018 National Three Position Air Rifle Championship by firing either an automatic qualifying score in a State Junior Olympic 3PAR Championship or by invitation after all matches have been fired and results uploaded to CMP.

The National 3PAR Championship is scheduled for June 2018 at Camp Perry, Ohio. This match will be a combined event with the CMP National Championship. The combined event was used as a way to reduce travel and expenses incurred by junior programs.

State Match Sanctioning Requirements

- Maximum of three matches per state (locations and/or dates)
 - While recognizing the importance and need for shoulder to shoulder competitions while at the same time sympathizing to conflicting schedules that plague every athlete, coach, and match director we will be allowing multiple locations/ dates up to the maximum of 3 per state. Hopefully, this enables states to maximum participation and reach in the state while maintaining true shoulder to shoulder competition.
- Minimum of 3 teams/ clubs represented and 12 individuals in each class per match
 - This requirement will be waived in cases where a state has one competition and is still unable to meet the participation minimums and on a case by case basis when we are notified in advance by match directors of potential problems with this requirement.
- Each athlete will only be able to fire in ONE Junior Olympic 3PAR State Championship
 - If athletes want additional match experience they may fire in subsequent matches, but must tell the match director to be left off of the match results when score reporting to CMP
- Teams must be named prior to the first team member firing
 - Teams must meet the requirements in rule 3.2
 - Team members are NOT required to fire on the same relay or day, but all four firing members must be named and turned in to the match director prior to the first team member shooting.
- Targets must be scored with Orion or mailed to CMP for official scoring within 2 weeks of the match or by May 5th.
- Medals/ award distribution for the state is up to the match director(s)
- EIC points will be awarded as scores are posted to the CMP website and will be based on cut scores as listed in the current National Standard rule book.
