The Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) Talladega Marksmanship Park invites you to participate in its **Talladega High Power 800 Point Monthly Match**. These matches are open to the public; new or experience shooters are welcome.

KONGSBERG ELECTRONIC TARGETS:

All firing will be completed on Kongsberg Electronic Targets (KTS). The KTS system, installed at each 200, 300, and 600 yard line registers each shot and relays the location and score value to a monitor beside each shooter on the firing line. All target operations, including final scoring, will be controlled from a range center command booth.

SAFETY RULES:

The use of ECI's (Empty Chamber Indicators) in all rifle and pistols is required at the CMP Talladega Marksmanship Park. The ECI is a brightly colored safety flag that is inserted into the chamber of the firearm. ECI's provide visual confirmation that firearms are unloaded. ECI's must be inserted after rifles are uncased and when not firing or in preparation period. ECI's will be available on the range for those that do not have them.

Range Safety Card-

A CMP range safety card is mandatory to fire on the ranges. Range safety cards are received after taking the safety class at the CMP Park Club House. Classes will be held every morning before the relays begin firing. Must be renewed yearly.

COMPETITION EVENT:

1000 Aggregate Match:

- ⊙ 2 sighters & 20 record shots, 200 yards, slow fire standing
 - ⊙ 2 sighters & 20 record shots, 200 yards, rapid fire sitting
 - ⊙ 2 sighters & 20 record shots, 300 yards, rapid fire prone
 - ⊙ 2 sighters & 20 record shots, 600 yards, slow fire prone
- Entry fee into this match is \$50 for Adults, \$25 for Juniors

AWARDS:

The winners of the 800 Point aggregate will be awarded Certificates OR Medals.

SANCTIONING & RULES:

This match is a CMP registered Match.
Service and Match rifles are allowed.

The competition will be governed in accordance with CMP High Power Rules, 2019 edition.

SQUADDING:

For each relay, 50 targets will be used. There will be one or two relays for these matches. The first relay will fire while the second relay verifies scores, and then the relays will switch.

SCORE POSTING:

All scores fired will be displayed in the CMP Competitor Tracker results system at www.thecmp.org as soon as the electronic targets score them. Scores and competitor rankings will be displayed in the Club House throughout the competition. Preliminary and final printed results bulletins will be posted in the Club House.

Competitors who are age 18 or older must complete and sign a notarized CMP Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement. This can be completed prior to arrival or it may be signed at the Marksmanship Center (a notary will be available). Competitors under the age of 18 must provide a Parent Consent Form completed upon arrival. You can print the Junior Liability Release by going to http://thecmp.org/wp-content/uploads/Jr_Release.pdf. Competitors must be 10 years or older to compete in matches at the Talladega Marksmanship Park.

DIRECTIONS TO RANGE:



The Talladega Marksmanship Park is located approximately 5 miles behind the Talladega Superspeedway race track.

From I-20 East (Atlanta)

Take exit 173 South off I-20
Follow Speedway Blvd to Allen Rd
Turn South (left) on Allen Rd
Turn right onto Jackson Trace Rd
Turn East (left) onto Turner Mill Rd
The Marksmanship Park will be on the South (left) of the road.

From I-20 West (Birmingham)

Take exit 168 South off I-20
Turn East (left) onto Speedway Blvd
Turn South (left) on Allen Rd
Turn right onto Jackson Trace Rd
Turn East (left) onto Turner Mill Rd
The Marksmanship Park will be on the South (left) of the road.
