

2018 Western CMP Smallbore Regional Phoenix, AZ October 20-21, 2018

The CMP is excited to offer the first ever CMP Smallbore Regional Competition, to be held during the 2018 Western CMP Games and Cup Matches at the Ben Avery Shooting Facility. In July 2018, the CMP hosted its first Smallbore National Championships and is now looking to offer more smallbore competitions beginning in Phoenix. This competition will feature two days of conventional prone.

Schedule: 07:30 start time both days. There will be 20-minute breaks between each match.

Saturday October 20 – Iron Sights (1600)

- Match #1 – 40 Shots @ 50 Yards
- Match #2 – 40 Shots @ 50 Meters
- Match #3 – 40 Shots Dewar Course
- Match #4 – 40 Shots @ 100 Yards
- Match #5 – Iron Sight Aggregate

Sunday October 21 – Any Sights (1600)

- Match #6 – 40 Shots @ 50 Yards
- Match #7 – 40 Shots @ 50 Meters
- Match #8 – 40 Shots Dewar Course
- Match #9 – 40 Shots @ 100 Yards
- Match #10 – Any Sight Aggregate
- Match #11 – 3200 Aggregate

BBQ and Awards – 4:30pm. (at the conclusion of the CMP Rimfire Sporter Match)

Fees: \$90 Open and \$75 Junior

Location and Facility: The matches will take place at the Ben Avery Shooting Facility at 4044 W Black Canyon Blvd, Phoenix, AZ 85086

Organizer: The competition is organized and conducted by the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP).

Eligibility: This is an open competition. Juniors and adults are welcome.

Classification: The CMP Smallbore Classification system is under development. However, NRA and USA Shooting Classifications will be recognized. (USA Shooting - AA or A = Master, B = Expert, C = Sharp Shooter, D = Marksman)

Rules: The new CMP Smallbore Rules will govern. The rules can be downloaded at: <http://thecmp.org/wp-content/uploads/SmallboreRulebook.pdf>

Scoring: This competition will be scored using the newly developed Orion Scoring System scoring app. At the conclusion of each stage, range officers will go downrange to photograph targets using iPods. The images will then be transmitted to a computer to be scored. Shooters will be able to

review their targets and scores at the conclusion of the match. Any shooter wishing to review their scores may bring the target to the statistical officer.

Preliminary scores will be posted live on the Orion Scoring Systems results center as the targets are being scored. All final results will be posted on the CMP Club and Competition Tracker.

Awards:

The top 3 overall and top 3 juniors in Match #5 and Match #10 will receive medals. The high open and junior shooters from Match #11 will receive a plaque.

Along with medals, the winners of Match #5, Match #10 and Match #11 will receive a brick of ammunition donated by Lapua. The high junior in Match #11 will receive a brick of ammunition donated by Eley.

Monetary prizes will also be presented for each match in each classification.

National Records: Scores for this competition will be eligible for CMP National Records. Rule 11.
