Ohio Governor Ted Strickland Opens the 2010 National Matches

Ohio Governor Ted Strickland fired a historical Sharps-Borchardt Model 1878 single shot rifle to open the 2010 National Matches.

CAMP PERRY, OHIO – The presence of the late U.S. Representative John Murtha of Pennsylvania was felt throughout the proceedings at the First Shot Ceremony on Monday, 12 July on Rodriguez Range adjoining the Shooters Memorial Plaza.

The National Matches include the CMP National Trophy Pistol and Rifle Matches, the Pistol and Rifle Small Arms Firing Schools, CMP Games rifle events and the NRA National Pistol, Smallbore Rifle and Highpower Rifle Championships. The matches are conducted jointly each year by the CMP and the NRA and are hosted by the Ohio National Guard.

A staunch supporter of U.S. troops and shooting sports, Rep. Murtha was the first veteran of the Vietnam War to enter Congress and one of the House's most influential lawmakers. He died unexpectedly on 8 February, 2010 due to complications from gall bladder surgery. He was honored by First Shot Ceremony featured speaker Ohio Governor Ted Strickland and later by USMC Col. (Ret.) John Hugya, Rep. Murtha's Chief of Staff and friend of 51 years.

"I am especially honored to be here this evening because I know that were it not for his untimely death, our friend the great Congressman John Murtha would be standing where I'm standing and he would be shooting the first shot," Gov. Strickland said in his opening remarks.

"It's impossible to stand in his place or to replace him, but we do honor him tonight."

A special pair of memorial bricks bearing Rep. Murtha's years of service was placed in the Shooters Memorial Plaza and a replica brick was presented to Col. Hugya to deliver to Rep. Murtha's widow, Joyce.

The ceremony marked the opening of the nation's most prestigious rifle and pistol competition, a tradition that dates back to the late 1800s and has been a part of Camp Perry tradition for 103 years.

"Since 1907, the nation's finest marksmen have been gathering here at Camp Perry to test themselves against the very best competition that exists. Along the way, the National Matches have honed the skills and deepened the pride in their country of countless participants," he said.

"The Civilian Marksmanship Program and the National Matches began more than a century ago with a commitment from President Theodore Roosevelt and the Congress to strengthen our national defense by improving the marksmanship skills of Americans," he said.

The Governor also expressed pride in the state of Ohio for being home to the National Matches, citing the economic impact on the local economy and the preservation of the Matches as the "World Series of the Shooting Sports."

"You know in Ohio we have a long cultural tradition of the shooting sports and we have an even longer tradition of answering the call to duty. In fact, Ohio is the proud home of more than 900,000 veterans. And that's why I think it is fitting that Ohio is home to the National Matches."

The ceremony featured many colorful and exciting moments including the ceremonial first shot by Gov. Strickland who fired a .45-70 round downrange from a Sharps-Borchardt Model 1878 single shot rifle from the original collection of Col. George W. Wingate, an officer in the 22nd Regiment of the New York National Guard. He was the first official secretary of the NRA and later president of the organization for 25 years, according to Michael P. Keefe, the rifle's current owner.

It's likely the rifle was used by Col. Wingate in competition at the National Matches in 1880s at Creedmoor in New York State. The matches were later relocated to the larger ranges of Camp Perry in 1907.

Gov. Strickland also welcomed the more than six thousand shooters from across America and the officials, volunteers and staff and those who support their efforts including the Ohio National Guard, CMP and NRA who work together to conduct the Matches.

Prior to the governor's opening shot, members of the Ohio Air National Guard 19th Special Forces arrived by parachute with the official American Flag to be flown throughout the matches. The parachute drop was made from a UH-60 Blackhawk helicopter.

The 122nd Army Band provided music throughout the event and members of the Lorain High School (Ohio) Army JROTC raised the colors.

Other speakers included Master of Ceremony Gary Anderson, Director of Civilian Marksmanship Emeritus, Major General Gregory Wayt, Ohio National Guard, Judith Legerski, CMP Board of Directors Vice Chair, Chaplain COL Andrew Aquino and Col. (Ret.) John Hugya, USMC.

National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches



The National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches are the annual U. S. national championship in service pistol and service rifle shooting. The National Trophy Matches were established by federal law in 1903, are still conducted under the statutory authority of the U. S. Code (Title 36 USC § 40725-40727) and are now governed by the Civilian Marksmanship Program. Shooters from all over the U. S., civilian and military, test their skills and compete to determine the nation's best service pistol and rifle shooters. To fulfill the CMP's statutory responsibility to "instruct citizens in marksmanship," the National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches are open to all shooters regardless of skill level. Beginners compete and learn while shooting side by side with champions. The tradition of the matches and their competitions for prestigious national trophies celebrate marksmanship excellence and provide incentives to develop individual marksmanship skills, equipment and a national competition infrastructure. The CMP National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches are held in conjunction with the NRA National Rifle and Pistol Championships through a partnership between the two organizations. The Ohio National Guard and U. S. Army Reserves also provide vital support for the matches. The CMP National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches and the NRA National Rifle and Pistol Championships are collectively known as the **NATIONAL MATCHES**.

Veterans and New Shooters Alike Enhance Pistol Skills in 2010 SAFS Course

ry firing line and bragging rights back at the hut, lodge or hotel.

This year's EIC winner Jennifer Schunemann, a veteran shooter but new to the M9 service pistol, said she learned more about the sport, received excellent instruction from her military coach and helped out a first-time shooter who shared the adjoining firing point who improved in the short time they fired together.

So if you haven't shot a pistol in a competition before or perhaps never at all, but are willing to take the time to learn from the best, the CMP-USAMU Small Arms Firing School is a great place to start.

"That's the benefit of entering a program like this," says Susan Jones who made the trip from Manhattan in the heart of New York City. Jones is a .22 caliber pistol competitor who is also looking to become a pistol coach and was looking forward to a coaching clinic at Camp Perry during the National Matches to help meet that goal.

"Many times you learn from your students," Jones said. A Women's Wilderness Experience veteran, Jones said she enjoys teaching because it's a mutually-rewarding process.

Her military coach at SAFS, SSG Jeremy Hartwell, a National Guardsman from Nebraska, helped Jones improve her shooting hand stability with a forearm strengthening exercise, she said. "It made a remarkable difference," she added.

Jones attended SAFS with her friend Michael Brygider, 51, of Stroudsburg, Pennsylvania. It was his first SAFS course and second trip to Camp Perry, Brygider said.



Brygider's wit and lightheartedness made him a hit on the firing line. A photographer by trade, he drew laughs when he pulled out his own custom-made shooting glasses shade which masks his left eye during shooting. The shade features photographs of his left eye from two different angles (see photo above).



Christopher La Chance and his father Ray participated in SAFS Pistol for the first time and are looking forward to returning to Camp Perry for SAFS Rifle at month end.

"I'm a fan of the sport and I'm getting re-acquainted with competitive shooting after 20 to 25 years off," he said.

I enjoy shooting because of the precision that's required," he added. Brygider said he learned a few new tips and also used the SAFS program to help him prepare for pistol week at the National Matches.

"When you want to learn something new, go to the pros I've always said. They don't get much better than these," he said.

Dr. Gary Waltz, 57, of Lyndhurst, Ohio, attended this year's SAFS for the first time and is totally new to the sport of pistol shooting. Having recently trained for and receiving his conceal-carry permit, he was looking for additional pistol training.

"I'm a history buff, particularly World War II and an avid reader of J.D. Salinger's work," he said. "One of history's characters I've always admired was Annie Oakley – there's something about the poise and grace she brought to shooting," he added.

Dr. Waltz said he was highly impressed by the training offered by the military at SAFS. "I didn't know very much at all about shooting a pistol and our military instructor had me continuously improving."

Ray La Chance, 47, and his son Christopher, 14, of New York enrolled in the SAFS program for the first time this year as well.

"I'm very interested in shooting sports and support of our Second Amendment rights," Ray said. He said he plans to return for SAFS for Rifle at the end of August and plans to bring Christopher back along with his daughter.

Christopher La Chance said the AR15 is his favorite gun to shoot and is looking forward to coming back for Rifle SAFS where he has an opportunity to learn the fundamentals of marksmanship from USAMU instructors.

USAMU, in conjunction with CMP and assisted by Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Air Force and Coast Guard coaches, conducts the Small Arms Firing Schools each year during the National Matches. The auditorium was conducted by USAMU's SSG Adam Sokolowski. The classroom instruction was followed with a session on the range; then the shooters completed the day by firing a practice match and the EIC match.

By consolidating SAFS to one day, it enabled CMP to run a Service Pistol Warm-Up Match on Tuesday. In addition, the USAMU conducted an Advanced Small Arms Firing School which was attended by nearly 100 experienced shooters.

"Our original program covered five basic areas including familiarity with the M9 Service Pistol, Introduction to Fundamentals, Introduction to Competition, Mental Management and Training Plans," said SFC Jason St. John.

"The mandate of the Small Arms Firing School is to introduce the civilian population the military sidearm, in our case, the M9 Service Pistol. So for the basic program we decided to cut off the competition and mental management side of it, and kept to familiarity, fundamentals and training plans. That gave us an additional 45 minutes to include an actual hands-on training session before students even fired," SFC St. John said. "It is essentially an extension of

the fundamentals class."

On the range students fired Beretta M9 ball guns at 25-yard targets. The course of fire during the range training included a slow-fire stage of 10-rounds in five minutes, a timed-fire stage of two-strings of five-rounds in 20 seconds each and a rapid-fire stage of two-strings of five-rounds in 10 seconds each.

SFC St. John said the hands-on segment allowed students to gain familiarity with safety and firing functions of the M9 prior to firing on the range. Combining the hands-on portion of the program with practice firing, then immediately moving to the EIC match, added continuity to the program.

"Students got immediate feedback from their coaches after practice firing and were able to take that knowledge directly to the line for the introductory EIC match. Now they have it all at one time with the same gun and the same instructor, then they roll right into their match."

"In the advanced course, we wanted to do everything we could to give back to the competitive public. We wanted to tell the advanced students what we focus on to get our shooters to the next level," SFC St. John explained.

The advanced course centered on four basic areas: Equipment, Fundamentals, Training Plans and Mental Preparedness.

All participants in the Pistol SAFS were awarded an M9 EIC pin, a SAFS T-shirt and certificate of completion, and some earned EIC credits toward their Distinguished Pistol Badge as part of the EIC Match.

Schunemann Earns Intro EIC Leg Points With Victory in First-Ever M9 Match

CAMP PERRY, OHIO – In her first-ever competition with an M9 service pistol, Jennifer Schunemann surprised everyone including herself by winning the 2010 National Matches M9 Excellence-In-Competition Match for non-distinguished pistol shooters on Monday, 13 July.

"It's mind-blowing," Schunemann said as she reflected on her accomplishment one day later.

Schunemann, 42, of Winter Haven, Florida, fired a 267-3X score out of a possible 300 with a rack grade Beretta M9 service pistol, issued on the line during the 2010 CMP-US Army Marksmanship Unit Small Arms Firing School for pistol.

An accomplished .45 and .22 caliber pistol competitor and NRA basic safety instructor, Schunemann finished third overall and earned her first four "leg" points toward her 30-point Distinguished Pistol Badge.

Rebekah Jennings (271-5X) and Chad Bruske (268-5X) captured first and second place in the EIC match overall.

The EIC match follows a one-day SAFS basic pistol school, designed to educate shooters in safe handling and marksmanship using the Army's standard sidearm – the Beretta M9. Students participate in a two-hour classroom session covering M9 safety, function and general marksmanship skills followed by continued training on the firing line.

Training concludes with a 30-shot practice match featuring 10-shot slow-fire, timed-fire and rapid-fire phases. Immediately after the practice match, participants fire an identical EIC match at 25 yards using the same USAMU-issued M9 pistol used in practice.

Shooting next to her husband Mike, 62, in their first SAFS class, Schunemann said she was actually disappointed with her score because she shot several points better in the practice round.

"I had no idea that I won the non-distinguished match. I'm just tickled," she said.

Schunemann said later she checked the results posting and was stunned to see herself on top. She said she checked back several times because she knew the postings were unofficial.

In the end she finished on the top out of 378 non-distinguished shooters and third out of 410 competitors overall.

Schunemann and her husband are



spending the entire National Matches at Camp Perry, competing in as many matches as possible, both pistol and rifle. She said her pistol resume is expanding into .38 caliber, but still needs work.

"It's a dream shooters vacation for us," she said. The couple is retired and it's the first opportunity they've had to spend the entire six weeks shooting CMP and NRA matches.

Schunemann credited her SAFS Pistol firing line instructor SSG Nick Capko, USMC, for helping her during her EIC practice match.

"Everyone has given me great instruction," she said. "I'm just here to have fun!"


If Schunemann's first day at the National Matches is any indication of what's to come, it could be one of her best vacations ever.

U.S. Army Marksmanship Unit dominates National Trophy Pistol Matches

CAMP PERRY, OHIO – Members of the U.S. Army Marksmanship Unit took top honors once again in the President's Pistol Trophy Match, National Trophy Individual Pistol Match and National Trophy Team Pistol Match at the 2010 CMP National Trophy Pistol Matches, Sunday, 18 July.

SSG Robert Park II, 31, of Fort Mitchell, Alabama, led the field in the prestigious President's Pistol Match with an aggregate score of 389-19X out of a possible 400 with civilian John Zurek, Jr., 46, of Tucson, Arizona, six points back at 383-13X and SSG Jason Hedrick, USMCR, 34, of Williamsburg, West Virginia, followed closely with a 382-14X for third place. SSG Park receives an M1911 Caspian pistol donated by Caspian Arms, barrel donated by Schuemann Barrels, and gunsmithed by USAMU armorers and an engraved Benchmade Model 890 Torrent presentation knife donated by Benchmade.

Judy Tant, 60, of East Lansing, Michigan, won the High Women's title in the President's Pistol Match with an aggregate score of 365-5X. SSG Cara Krauss, ARNG, 29, of Bristol, Vermont, placed second with a 349-5X and Tara Poremba, 37, of Chicago, Illinois, placed third with a score of 348-4X.

James Lenardson, 59, of Toledo, Ohio, was the high senior shooter in the President's match, firing a 382-11X. SFC Darwin Hukill, ARNG, 43, of Cassville, Missouri, led all M1911 pistol shooters in the match with a 371-6X. SFC Hukill was awarded a special M1911 Pistol donated by Springfield Armory.

The President's Pistol Match is a service pistol event featuring 20 slow-fire shots from 50 yards in 10 minutes, 10 timed-fire shots at 25 yards in 20 seconds and two-strings of five shots fired in 10 seconds each. The match has been fired since 1981.

James McCaig, 17, of Columbia, Tennessee, won the President's Pistol Junior Trophy firing a .22 caliber target pistol with an aggregate score of 363-5X. Rebekah Jennings, 19, of Boerne, Texas, placed second with a 356-3X and Blake Fleming, 18, of Gloucester Point, Virginia, finished third with an aggregate of 352-6X.

The President's 100 includes the top 100 competitors in the President's Pistol Match – each receiving a President's 100 Certificate and Medallion. The cut-off score for this year's match fired by John Voorhees, 68, of Romeo, Michigan, was 350-7X.

SFC James Henderson, 43, of Columbus,

Georgia, the defending President's and NTI champion, placed first in this year's NTI with an aggregate score of 292-10X. USAMU teammates SSG Lyman Grover, 41, of Columbus, Georgia, and SSG Park took second and third place honors in the NTI with scores of 292-9X and 290-7X, respectively. SFC Henderson was awarded a Colt M1911 Gold Cup pistol donated by Colt Firearms.

A variable breeze that increased throughout the day took the edge off the 90-degree heat but appeared to knock down scores of competitors across the board.

"Yep, the wind was definitely a factor and it increased as we went into the second relay (of the team match – the final event of the day)," SSG Park said afterward.

SSG Park and the remainder of the USAMU pistol team perennially chase SFC Henderson, who won the President's and NTI matches last year. It was SSG Park's second big victory having captured his first overall individual championship at the 51st Interservice Pistol championship matches in June at Ft. Benning, Georgia. He and SFC Henderson also finished first and second in the second annual warm-up pistol match on Tuesday, 13 July.

SSG Park will enjoy a short-lived spotlight as the team moves on. He is one of the USAMU's top marksmanship instructors and is slated to deploy this fall to Afghanistan as part of a cross-functional team of USAMU Soldiers training Afghan National Army Soldiers on the fundamentals of marksmanship.

SFC Henderson, who will also deploy to Afghanistan, said he was happy with his NTI victory and performance overall during the Matches. He credited the team for keeping him sharp.



SSG Robert Park II USA, led the field of 579 pistol shooters during the President's Pistol Match. SSG Park also captured the overall aggregate (President's, NTI and NTT) firing an aggregate of 967-39X.

"I can't win them all - I'm just glad one of our guys stepped up. I'm very happy with our team's success," SFC Henderson said following the awards presentation Sunday evening.

The NTI is a 300-point match fired with 10 shots of slow-fire at 50 yards in 10 minutes, 10 shots of timed-fire at 25 yards in 20 seconds and 10 shots of rapid-fire at 25 yards in two strings of five shots each at 25 yards. The NTI is an Excellence-in-Competition (EIC) match in which the top 10 percent of all Non-Distin-

guished competitors, military and civilian, earn EIC points that count towards earning the Distinguished Pistol Shot Badge.

The top civilian shooters in the NTI match were David Lange, 41, of Glen Rock, New Jersey, Steve Reiter, 68, of Tucson, Arizona, and Brian Zins, 41, of Poland, Ohio. Lange fired an aggregate score of 289-9X while Reiter scored a 288-8X and Zins finished with a 285-11X. Reiter was also the top senior in the match and was followed by James Lenardson (278-10X) and Robert McIlhaney, 61, of Allentown, Pennsylvania (277-6X).

The high NTI National Women's Trophy was SSG Cara Krauss, ARNG who fired a 279-5X, followed by Judy Tant (274-7X) and Kimberly Hobart, 45, of New Philadelphia, Ohio (255-3X).

Tant won the Rose Krelstein Trophy, signifying the high woman in aggregate of scores from the President's and NTI matches. Tant's aggregate of 639-12X was followed by SSG Krauss at 628-10X and Hobart at 600-5X.

In the four-person National Trophy Team Match, USAMU Blue won the Gold Cup Trophy with an aggregate score of 1141-32X. Members of the winning team were SSG Park, SFC Henderson, SSG Grover and SSG John Ennis IV, 34 of Fortson, Georgia.

The US Marine Corps Reserve team finished third by only four points with an aggregate score of 1101-20X. The top two-person junior team in the NTT Match was Texas Junior Gold, firing an aggregate score of 551-13X. Firing members were Zachary Hedrick, 17, of Boerne, Texas, and Rebekah Jennings. Texas Junior Gold is captained by David Deppe, 16, of Mico, Texas, and coached by

Kathleen Deppe, 44, of Mico, Texas. Second place went to Texas Junior Silver with a score of 514-6X, fired by Keaton Harlow, 18, of Pflugerville, Texas, and Rafe Corley, 18, of San Antonio, Texas, and were mentored by David and Kathleen Deppe.

Third place in the Junior NTT was captured by VSSA Juniors, Blake Fleming and Brad Fellows, 16, of Gloucester Point, Virginia, with an aggregate score of 513-5X. VSSA Juniors was captained and coached by Fleming and Fellows, respectively.

The overall aggregate (President's, NTI and NTT) was captured by SSG Park with an aggregate of 967-39X. SFC Henderson followed with a 961-34X and SSG Grover placed third overall with a 957-26X. Glock GmbH donated a Glock pistol to the High Law Enforcement

in the Overall Aggregate which was awarded to Special Agent Keith Hanzel, of Fredericksburg, Virginia, firing a 928-14X.

CAMP PERRY, OHIO – A pair of junior shooters from the state of New York made history on 18 July at the 2010 National Trophy Team Pistol Match by being the first junior team from their state to participate in the National Matches at Camp Perry, according to their coaches, Peter Militello and Paul Korn.


"You're watching history in the making," echoed Militello, 71, of Orchard Park, and Korn, 42, of Elma. "It happened thanks to the new law in the state of New York," Militello said.

Due to changes in New York law adopted in August 2006, New York juniors as young as 14 up to the age of 20 were allowed to learn to shoot handguns only at accredited shooting ranges, and under the supervision of a parent or guardian, military officer, a military or NRA-certified small arms instructor, or an adult certified in responsible hunting practices by the New York State Dept. of Environmental Conservation.

The change meant Eric Wagner, 16 of Elma and his teammate Rebecca Powers, 17, of West Falls could practice and compete as a team. It was Wagner's and Powers' first trip to Camp Perry as a team. Powers participated in the Matches for her third time as an individual this year. It was Wagner's first. The team was sponsored by the Ten-X Shooting Club in Lancaster, New York.

It's Wagner's first year of competitive shooting and he has fired in three matches so far in 2010. When asked how he felt about his first experience at Camp Perry, he said "I'm hungry!"

Powers, a winter and league shooter, said she has enjoyed her Camp Perry experience in each of her three campaigns here as a junior. "I love the people; I'm having lots of fun

and I'm looking forward to coming back next year," she said.

Her father, Rick, 52, also a competitive shooter, said "It's great, I love that she wants to shoot with me."

The team was also accompanied by Robert Korn, 57, of Cheektowaga, New York, a veteran of 31 years of pistol competition. It was his second trip to Camp Perry.

Junior pistol shooters from the state of Texas also left their boot prints on the 2010 CMP National Trophy Pistol Matches, taking

the top two team positions and a few individual places as well. All junior matches are fired with a .22 caliber match pistol.

Rebekah Jennings, 19, of Boerne, Texas, was the overall aggregate points leader which combines the aggregate total of the Junior President's Trophy, National Individual Trophy and National Team Trophy events with a score of 916-23X. Fellow Texan Zachary Hedrick, 17, also of Boerne was second with a combined aggregate of 888-16X and Keaton Harlow, 18, of Pflugerville finished third

with a total of 866-13X to complete the Texas sweep.

Jennings won the NTI Junior G.P. "Perry" DeFino trophy with a score of 285, landing an amazing 15 of her 30 shots in the X-ring, 10 more than her nearest competitor. With the score of 285-15X, she set a new National Record for the Junior NTI Match. She also backed up Hedrick in the two-person team match that gave Texas Gold its victory. Hedrick fired a 276-8X with Jennings on his heels at 275-5X.

The Texas Silver team of Harlow and Rafe Corley, 19, of San Antonio, placed second in the match with an aggregate score of 514-6X followed closely by VSSA Juniors with a 513-5X. VSSA (Virginia Shooting Sports Association) Juniors was led by Blake Fleming, 18, of Gloucester Point and Walker Buckman, 14, of Lovettsville with scores of 260-2X and 253-3X, respectively.

James McCaig, 18, of Columbia, Tennessee, won the prestigious Junior President's Trophy with an aggregate score of 363-5X, topping Jennings at 356-3X and Fleming who fired a 352-6X.

Early in the week Jennings shot a 271-5X with a rack grade M9 9mm pistol in the

CMP-USAMU Small Arms Firing School Excellence-In-Competition Match to lead all shooters. Because she already has leg points toward her Distinguished Pistol Shot Badge, she was ineligible to win the M9 Award Plaque.

Christopher Hudock, 19, of Raleigh, North Carolina, was the high junior shooter in the Service Pistol Warm-Up Match on Tuesday, 13 July. Hudock fired a .22 caliber smallbore sport pistol in the match.

Juniors also flocked in record numbers to the CMP's airgun Competition Center during



CMP's Air Gun Events Draw Record Number of National Match Competitors

CAMP PERRY, OHIO – A record number of air gun pistol competitors entered the National Matches Air Gun Events at the Camp Perry Marksmanship Training Center during pistol week, according to Brad Donoho, Program Coordinator. Several shooters participated in the National Match Air Pistol Competition for the first time in the re-entry matches and 60-shot Air Pistol Championship Match at the three-year-old venue.

The Overall Match Winner in the air pistol championship and defending 2009 champion with a score of 571-14X was John Zurek Jr. of Chandler, Arizona. Zurek, who also participated in the National Trophy Pistol Matches, was this year's high-scoring civilian in the President's Pistol Trophy Match.

The High Senior in the National Matches Air Pistol Championship was Gary Peterson, 62, of Levittown, New York, with a score of 555-11X. The High Junior in the air pistol championship was Jacob Hedrick, 20, of Boerne, Texas, who shot a score of 547-6X and the High Woman in the championship was Shelby Cammack, 19, of Sturgis, South Dakota, with a score of 545-8X.

Donoho reported that 383 entries were logged during pistol week in unlimited re-entry air pistol matches and the 60-shot championship event, many of which were junior shooters. He said in 2008, the new Competition Center had approximately 100 entries and that more than doubled to 259 in 2009 and has climbed once again to 383, which are dramatic increases.

"What's interesting is that several competitors don't realize that the air gun range is no longer between buildings on Commercial Row. Our facility is air conditioned and features 80 electronically-scored firing points – quite a contrast to the old air gun range," Donoho said.

"Of course the more entries we have, the larger the cash prize becomes for the championship and challenge matches," he said.

The Competition Center remained open during the CMP highpower rifle phase which ran through 7 August.
