First Shot Kicks Off National Matches

PORT CLINTON — A loud bang rang out as a bullet fired out of a rifle and zipped down range at Camp Perry.

Major General John C. Harris Jr. fired the ceremonial first shot Monday morning to officially kickoff to this year's National Matches.

The matches, a five-week shooting competition, features national and international marksmen. The marksmen use both short- and long-range firearms to shoot targets at varying distances at the gun ranges at Camp Perry.

The National Matches are organized by the National Rifle Association and the Civilian Marksmanship Program.

"Program records show the number of competitors who normally attend the National Matches averages out to more than 6,500 each year," said Larry Fletcher, director of Lake Erie Shores and Islands, the region's tourism bureau. "Those folks, because of the long stretch of competition, make a significant economic impact."

Fletcher said the National Matches help generate almost \$20 million in revenue, from hotels, restaurants and other sources.

Harris, along with numerous veterans, government officials and contest participants, attended Monday's first shot ceremony.

During an opening speech, Harris shared inspiring stories about determined veterans and inspiring young competition shooters.

"Its those traits that make competition shooters so great," Harris said. "The system— weapon plus shooter — is at the center of these matches. Technology may have changed, but the shooters are unchanged."

Harris lauded Camp Perry's historic facility and the thousands of shooters who make the competition possible.

A total of 1,574 event entries were recorded and 638 individual shooters participated in the 2017 Pistol Small Arms Firing School and/or National Match competitions. The CMP thanks all of you for joining us at Camp Perry for this year's events.

The 2017 CMP National Trophy Pistol Matches began on 1 July with the Pistol Small Arms Firing School and the Service Pistol EIC Match and the .22 Rimfire Pistol EIC Matches, with the remaining matches fired on 2 July. Again, the Matches showcased a number of exceptional marksmen, including:

- ◎ This year's M9 EIC Match winner, junior Brannon Sickels, 19, of Frisco, TX, who earned a score of 264-6x.
- ◎ SFC Patrick Franks, Jr., 39, of the Army Marksmanship Unit (AMU), who was the overall winner of the National Trophy Individual (NTI) Match by 2 points, fired a score of 289-10x.
- ◎ SFC James Henderson, USA, who was the overall winner of the President's 100 Match, the top Army competitor in the NTI-NTT Aggregate earning the General Patton Trophy, a firing member on the USAMU Blue team earning the Gold Cup Trophy in the NTT and was also named the overall Service Pistol competitor of the National Trophy Pistol Matches.
- ◎ Junior Samuel Kwon, 17, of New York, NY, earned the top spots in the Junior President's Match and Junior National Trophy Individual Pistol Match to receive the Junior President's Plaque and G.P. Perry DeFino Trophy.
- ◎ SFC Lawrence Cleveland, 32, of the AMU, who recorded a score of 291-9x to become the overall winner of the .22 Rimfire EIC Pistol Match.
- ◎ Judy Tant, 67, of East Lansing, MI, who was the High Woman of the National Trophy Individual Matches for the third consecutive year.

National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches

*The National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches are the annual U. S. National Championship in service pistol and service rifle shooting. The National Trophy Matches were established by federal law in 1903, are still conducted under the statutory authority of the U. S. Code (Title 36 USC § 40725-40727) and are now governed by the Civilian Marksmanship Program. Shooters from all over the U. S., civilian and military, test their skills and compete to determine the nation's best service pistol and rifle shooters. To fulfill the CMP's statutory responsibility to "instruct citizens in marksmanship," the National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches are open to all shooters regardless of skill level. Beginners compete and learn while shooting side by side with champions. The tradition of the matches and their competitions for prestigious national trophies celebrate marksmanship excellence and provide incentives to develop individual marksmanship skills, equipment and a national competition infrastructure. The CMP National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches are held in conjunction with the NRA National Rifle and Pistol Championships through a partnership between the two organizations. The Ohio National Guard and U. S. Army Reserves also provide vital support for the matches. The CMP National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches and the NRA National Rifle and Pistol Championships are collectively known as the **NATIONAL MATCHES**.*

Unanticipated Crowd Fires at Inaugural Glock Match at Camp Perry

CAMP PERRY, Ohio – The Inaugural GLOCK Sport Shooting Foundation (GSSF) Camp Perry National Challenge enormously exceeded all expectations. The match, fired July 1 at the Civilian Marksmanship Program's (CMP) National Trophy Pistol Matches, saw a total of 244 entries throughout the day – an unprecedented number for the GLOCK team members.

"I mean, we ran out of targets!" said Joseph "Willie" Parent, the director of GSSF training at GLOCK who was ecstatic about the turnout for the event. "We honestly didn't know what to expect bringing GLOCK to Camp Perry and not having any sort of fingerprint here. It blew everyone's expectations away."

Before GLOCK arrived to the shores of Lake Erie in July, they kept a close eye on the number of entries in order to be able to appropriately prepare for the event. Though only about 50 people had entered the match by the time they took off on their journey, the crew of sales, marketing and GSSF team members came prepared with targets for around 200 competitors – just in case.

By the end of the match, GLOCK was out of targets, forcing them to begin using pasters to cover the shot holes. It was a shocking and encouraging sign for everyone involved with the event.

"Next year, we'll come back bigger and better. We'll be better prepared because now we know what to expect," said Parent. "We set a standard, and next year we're going to exceed it."

The GSSF Match at Camp Perry was introduced to the public in April 2017. In late June, GLOCK announced that the crew would be bringing along loaner pistols for anyone who wanted to fire in the event and didn't have a GLOCK of his/her own at an attempt to provide even more opportunities to guests of the Matches. In total, GLOCK loaned out pistols 62 times – undoubtedly adding a greater participation to the competition.

Even CMP programs chief, Christie Sewell, who stayed present on the range throughout the entire event, borrowed a pistol and felt compelled to compete after observing the joy on the faces of competitors throughout the day. She was delighted to see the number of men, women and juniors who continuously stepped up to the firing line and was also pleased with the efficiency with which the match was conducted.

"All of us at the CMP were as excited as GLOCK for the overwhelming turnout of the inaugural match at Camp Perry," said Sewell. "GLOCK has always been a generous contributor to our matches, and we are happy that we could help facilitate an event that combines our forces to further the promotion of marksmanship."

"The unbelievable amount of participation from our competitors at this event was a tremendous start to what we hope will be a lasting competition at the National Matches," she added.

The Course of Fire for the match was set at distances of 5, 7, 10, 15 and 25 yards – 10 rounds at each in a time limit of 15 seconds. The close proximity and rapid-fire sequences gave the match a structure that allowed new marksmen to feel comfortable in a competitive setting, while also providing a unique challenge for the more experienced crowd.

Two classes were set during the event: Stock Class and Unlimited. GLOCK firearms were considered stock if all firearm components are or ever have been available from GLOCK, Inc., with certain additional allowable modifications as stated in the match rules. Other specific modifications were placed in the Unlimited Class. GSSF awards are determined by dividing the results into thirds – with the top-third considered "A Class," and so on.

Winning the High Guardian and Overall Stock GLOCK match A Class and setting an outstanding precedent was SFC Keith Sanderson, 42, of the U.S. Army Reserve, who fired an incredible score of 500-47x. Also recording an exceptional score was Sgt. Carl Clegg, 31, of the U.S. Marine Corps, with 498-44x for second place, followed by civilian Craig Odom, 56, of Du Quoin, IL, who earned an aggregate score of 496-41x to take third. Odom was also the High Senior of the match.

First place B Class was Keith Raisor, 48, of Lawrence, IN, with a score of 479-27x, as John Ball, 44, of Brunswick, OH, overtook the C Class category, with an overall score of 436-26x.

Securing the High Lady title was Lois Kaminski, 50, of Lansing, MI, who fired a score of 484-33x. Derek King, 18, of Raymond, OH, claimed the High Junior honor by only two x's, recording a score of 477-28x to top past and current National Junior champion, Sam Kwon, 17, of New York, NY.

Also contributing a remarkable string of scores during the event was Jonathan Shue, 35, of Mebane, NC, who fired an aggregate of 500-44x to win the Unlimited class. SPC Anthony Heinauer, 21, of the U.S. Army, trailed just behind Shue in the 500 Club with a score of 500-37x, followed by George Gustafson, 68, of Pottsville, MI, with a score of 498-45x for third.

Each overall and category winner in the match was presented a certificate for a GLOCK pistol along with his/her award. Additionally, GLOCK donated another pistol to be awarded at random draw. Mark Lucas, 65, of Marblehead, OH, was the lucky winner of the pistol prize.

The CMP would like to thank GLOCK for all of their hard work and dedication to shooting sports and to the organization. The CMP would also like to thank all of the competitors for setting an outstanding first year. The GSSF Camp Perry National Challenge already has its place reserved on the schedule for the 2018 National Matches, so plan ahead and come experience it for yourself!

U.S. AMU Members Claim Top Events at 2017 CMP National Trophy Pistol Matches

CAMP PERRY, Ohio – The U.S. Army Marksmanship Unit (AMU) swept the 2017 National Trophy Pistol Matches, held July 1 and 2 at Camp Perry, with its members claiming overall wins in each of the prestigious events, along with capturing the National Trophy Team (NTT) Match for the eleventh year.

Helping to lead the charge was SFC James Henderson, 50, of the AMU, who fired a score of 392-16x to win the President's Pistol Match for the eighth time over his career. Henderson is also the current record-holder of the match, along with holding the overall record for the National Trophy Individual (NTI) event.

"I try not to think about outcomes – I just do what I do, shot by shot. Winning's not really up to you," he said. "You can shoot an amazing score and someone can one-up you. I just try to do the best that I can for that day and see where it falls."

The 2017 National Matches stood as Henderson's last as a member of the AMU after he decided to retire with 32 total years of service in his lifetime – 12 Reserve and 20 Active. His team members, led by SFC Lawrence Cleveland, presented Henderson with a commemorative plaque during the Pistol Awards ceremony to show their heartfelt appreciation to him for his dedication over the years.

"I am humbled by the gratitude, friendship and love I have been shown by this group of soldiers. They have become family," Henderson said in tribute to his teammates. "I have taught them all I can, and I will always answer their calls."

For his win in the President's 100, SFC Henderson also received a Colt Gold Cup Pistol, donated by Colt Manufacturing.

Teammate SFC Patrick Franks, 39, of the AMU, was the overall winner of the NTI Pistol Match with a score of 289-10x. Now a multi-time winner of the event, Franks keeps a mental game similar to that of Henderson – saying although practice is important, sometimes, winning just depends on the day.

"I don't really train to win it all. I hope for the best. If it works, that's good, but if it doesn't, oh well. I try to treat it the same as every other match," he said. "I think you can't really prepare too much for Camp Perry because it's so unorthodox with the weather, the timing – holding up the line because there's an eagle downrange or boats in the impact area. So I just try to keep it as simple as possible and do what I know how to do."

SSG Ryan Franks, 29, of the AMU, brother of SFC Patrick Franks, overtook the EIC Pistol event by one point over team member SSG Greg Markowski – firing a score of 289-7x. Markowski, Henderson and teammates SSG Joshua Kingery and SFC Lawrence Cleveland combined talents to win the NTT competition with a score of 1112-26x.

SFC Franks served as captain of the winning team and spoke positively of the success of the AMU as a whole during their 2017 CMP National Match performances, saying, "I think it's amazing that everything that could be won with the CMP was won by a different person on our team. It

Continuing the AMU winnings, SFC Lawrence Cleveland, 32, overtook the .22 Rimfire Pistol EIC Match with a score of 291-9x. Sgt. Mack Williams, 30, of the Army Reserve National Guard, was the high non-distinguished competitor of the .22 event, with a score of 274-3x.

High Junior of the .22 Rimfire Match was Derek Rodriguez, 19, of Mount Pleasant, SC.

Other noteworthy showings during the Matches were given by Susan Fries, 54, of Lainsburg, MI, who earned the High Woman honor in the President’s Pistol Match, and Greg Abraham, 64, of Lake Crystal, MN, who was the High Senior of the event. Both received a Super Smoker, donated by Ray-Vin.

National Match Air Pistol Matches

National Match Air Gun events are fired concurrently with the National Match Pistol and Rifle matches. Those attending the outdoor events are welcome to take a walk to the Gary Anderson CMP Competition Center, located on the grounds of Camp Perry, and compete in any of the air pistol and air rifle events offered throughout the duration of the Matches. The indoor, air-conditioned air gun range holds 80 electronic target firing points, with large LED screens to keep spectators in on the action.

The facility also contains memorabilia from the career of decorated American marksman and CMP Emeritus, Gary Anderson. A two-time gold medalist, the collection includes authentic Olympic items, a medal from President John F. Kennedy and even a piece of the Berlin wall. Those competing as well as those just visiting are welcome to tour the facility, free of charge.

In air pistol, Dwaine Hurt, 53, of Red Oak, IA, was the overall winner of the 60 Shot event, with a score of 565-12x. Hurt also fired the high score in the 30 Shot Air Pistol Re-Entry Top Center Shot challenge.

A Top Center Shot was awarded during the 30 Shot Pistol Re-Entry Match to the competitor who fired the closest shot to center. This year's winner was Susan Jones, 62, of New York, NY. For her win, Jones received a monetary prize of \$165.50 from the CMP, based on the number of entries. The next seven closest competitors also received money for their efforts.

High Woman of the 60 Shot Pistol match was Shelly Liu, 47, of Cary, NC, with a score of 533-5x. Kyler Swisher, 18, of Jamestown, PA, earned the High Junior honor with a score of 553-9x, as Gary Peterson, 69, of Levittown, NY, came out of the match as High Senior, with a score of 538-8x.
