CMP's 2018 National Pistol and Rifle Matches Start Off With a Bang at Camp Perry

CAMP PERRY, Ohio – When most think of summertime in Port Clinton, they think beaches, boating and, in general, having an unlimited amount of fun in the water and on the shore. For others, summer in Port Clinton still means fun on the shoreline, but fun gearing up for the incomparable World Series of Shooting Sports at Camp Perry.

The National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches has welcomed millions of competitors and guests to the Port Clinton area since 1907. Embracing competitors from across the country, (and even some from countries like England and Australia, among others), the National Match event features a variety of rifle and pistol competitions and clinics for marksmen ranging from some of today's most prestigious shots to those who have never pulled a trigger. The National Matches are held to promote competition and excellence, while also striving to teach marksmanship safety and fundamentals to the old, young and everything in between.

The annual event at the Camp Perry National Guard Training Base is hosted by the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP), with help from the Ohio National Guard.

A Message from the COO:

The CMP is pleased to provide you with this complimentary printed edition of the Final Results of the 2018 National Trophy Pistol Matches. A total of 2,099 event entries were recorded and 786 individual shooters participated in the 2018 Pistol Small Arms Firing School and/or National Match competitions. The CMP thanks all of you for joining us at Camp Perry for this year's events.

The 2018 CMP National Trophy Pistol Matches began on 14 July with the Pistol Small Arms Firing School and the Service Pistol and .22 Rimfire Pistol EIC Matches, with the remaining matches fired on 15 July. As in past years, the Matches showcased a number of exceptional marksmen and markswomen, including:

- ⑥ This year's M9 EIC Match winner, Roy Leidy, 55, of Northampton, PA, who earned a score of 269-1x.
- ⑥ SSG Greg Markowski, 44, of the Army Marksmanship Unit (AMU), who was the overall winner of the National Trophy Individual (NTI) Match by just one point over teammate SGT Christopher Hudock, 28, who was the winner of the President's Pistol event. SSG Markowski was also the overall Service Pistol competitor.
- ⑥ SFC Adam Sokolowski, 39, of the AMU who led the Service Pistol EIC Match.
- ⑥ John Ennis, 42, of Honolulu, HI, who topped the .22 Rimfire Pistol EIC Match.
- ⑥ Junior Sam Kwon, 19, of New York, NY, who was the High Junior in the .22 Rimfire Pistol EIC Match and received the G.P. Perry DeFino Trophy for his win in the Junior Individual Match for the second consecutive year.
- ⑥ Heather Powers, 18, of West Falls, NY, who was the overall winner in the Junior President's Pistol Match. She and New York Rifle & Pistol Junior teammate, Sam Kwon, joined forces to earn the top spot in the Junior Team event.
- ⑥ Cadet Lisa Emmert, 22, of the Army National Guard, who was the winner of the National Woman's Trophy in the NTI event. Cadet Emmert was also the High Woman of the President's Match and earned the Rose Krelstein Trophy as the overall female competitor of the President's/NTI Aggregate.

National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches

The National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches are the annual U. S. National Championship in service pistol and service rifle shooting. The National Trophy Matches were established by federal law in 1903, are still conducted under the statutory authority of the U. S. Code (Title 36 USC § 40725-40727) and are now governed by the Civilian Marksmanship Program. Shooters from all over the U. S., civilian and military, test their skills and compete to determine the nation's best service pistol and rifle shooters. To fulfill the CMP's statutory responsibility to "instruct citizens in marksmanship," the National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches are open to all shooters regardless of skill level. Beginners compete and learn while shooting side by side with champions. The tradition of the matches and their competitions for prestigious national trophies celebrate marksmanship excellence and provide incentives to develop individual marksmanship skills, equipment and a national competition infrastructure. The CMP National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches are held in conjunction with the NRA National Rifle and Pistol Championships through a partnership between the two organizations. The Ohio National Guard and U. S. Army Reserves also provide vital support for the matches. The CMP National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches and the NRA National Rifle and Pistol Championships are collectively known as the **NATIONAL MATCHES**.

First Shot Ceremony Continued



Each year, the CMP pulls together a show of distinguished guests and historic elements to celebrate the official opening of the National Matches with its renowned First Shot Ceremony. The event is always open to the public and includes authentic vehicles from the past, including a World War II B25 bomber and a U.S. Navy TBM Avenger, along with a parade of Model T cars that provide free rides for guests. The ceremony concludes with a rifle shot fired downrange – signifying the “first shot” of the matches.

Members of the 555th Honors Detachment color guard from Wooster, Ohio, and veterans from a variety of wars were also in attendance, along with the Ohio National Guard’s 122nd Army Band. Mr. Lloyd Boyer, a 92-year-old veteran who served in field artillery in General Patton’s third Army in the European Theatre, proudly stood at the entrance of Rodriguez Range, where the event is held, fully dressed in uniform.

The ceremony began with the booming blasts of three historical cannons promptly at 10:00 a.m. – aimed down-range at Camp Perry’s iconic black and white firing lane numbers. CMP’s Chair of the Board, Judy Legerski, greeted the crowd and gave a short history of Camp Perry and the National Matches as she kept the ceremony moving.

A light and pleasant breeze cooled the morning air when the crowd in the stands at Shooters’ Plaza in front of Rodriguez Range suddenly turned their eyes to the bright blue sky overhead – the buzzing of the World War II aircrafts steadily growing from the distance as they approached the stands. Spectators cheered when the stunning aircraft flew low towards Lake Erie, giving a close view of their timeless craftsmanship. The planes then looped over the water to come back and wow the stands again, as bursting clouds from the pyrotechnics exploded on the range below to simulate an air strike.

After the planes left sight, a truly unforgettable display of American sacrifice and spirit cascaded to the ground when retired SFC Dana Bowman, a U.S. Special Forces Army Ranger and member of the Army’s Golden Knights parachute team, jumped from 6,000 feet and parachuted onto the range – towing behind him a massive 2,500 square-foot American Flag. Many were brought to tears as SFC Bowman gracefully descended towards the green range grass with the classic “God Bless the U.S.A.” ballad playing over the loudspeakers.

In 1994, during a parachute team practice with SGT Jose Aguililon, SFC Bowman collided with his teammate in air at nearly 300 miles per hour. SGT Aguililon was killed in the accident, while SFC Bowman’s legs were severed mid-air. Unwilling to be defeated by the disaster, he astoundingly became the first double-amputee to re-enlist in the Army and rejoined the Golden Knights, now jumping with specially-designed prosthetic legs.

A native of nearby North Ridgeville, Ohio, Bowman’s mother, sister and other family members were present at the ceremony. As founder

of the non-profit HALO for Freedom Warrior Foundation, Bowman became connected with the CMP after purchasing a few rifles from the sales department. When the idea of jumping at the First Shot Ceremony was discussed, he was more than happy to take part.

"This is my kind of team here," he said. "I got to speak and meet-and-greet with so many people."

Bowman seized the opportunity to shake the hands of veterans and children in the crowd after the First Shot, thanking the veterans for their service and implanting inspiration into the next generation of Americans – a common theme of the National Matches.

"Look what the CMP does for our youth. We can't forget about our youth," he said. "CMP instills from the beginning to never forget about why we're here. Our forefathers started this. Why not leave a legacy? I'm just glad to be part of it."

Distinguished guests at the First Shot Ceremony included Jon Husted, Ohio Secretary of State, Maj. Gen. Mark Bartmen, Ohio Adjutant General, Congresswoman Marcy Kaptur of Ohio's 9th district and CMP Board members.

This year's First Shot Speaker was Maj. Gen. Clark LeMasters, Jr., Commanding General of the U.S. Army Tank-automotive and Armaments Command and the Senior Commander of TACOM Life Cycle Management Command, U.S. Army Garrison-Detroit Arsenal, Mich. After briefly addressing the crowd, Maj. Gen. LeMasters strolled up to the 600-yard berm of Rodriguez Range, put on his eye and ear protection and fired the ceremonial "first shot" downrange with one of CMP's M1 Garand rifles. The target downrange exuded a puff of smoke to imitate the shot bursting on impact – marking the true start of the National Matches.

After the First Shot ceremony, those in attendance took a short walk across the street to witness the ribbon cutting ceremony of the new Hough Theatre, presented by the Ohio National Guard. Over the years, the interior of the auditorium has witnessed some of the greatest American marksmen in history and famous entertainers like Bob Hope and Bing Crosby. The \$1.6 million restoration of the theater pays homage to its beginnings in 1938, leaving some of its historical characteristics and adding modern conveniences that will accommodate guests well into the future.

The ribbon cutting ceremony also featured the pinning of a Bronze Star on one of Port Clinton's own Vietnam veterans, Steven Fultz, who served as an Army Staff Sergeant during the war. The medal was presented by Congresswoman Marcy Kaptur.

The first competitions of the CMP's 2018 National Matches begin on Saturday, July 14, with pistol and continue through Wednesday, August 8. Along with pistol, the CMP will also hold smallbore, service rifle, vintage rifle and long range rifle events and clinics. CMP staff and trained support members will be on the firing line at each competition to ensure safety throughout the National Matches.

Open to the public year-round, guests may visit the grounds of Camp Perry at any time to observe or participate in National Match competition, with festival-style food vendors and shopping opportunities open during event days. Entry and parking around base is completely free.

Reasonable Weather Finally Finds Competitors at 2018 CMP National Trophy Pistol Matches

CAMP PERRY, Ohio – Notorious for its difficult and rapidly-shifting rain, wind and storms during the summer season, the weather at the Camp Perry National Guard Training Facility actually gifted competitors with some of the best weather in years during the 2018 National Trophy Pistol Matches. Nearly 800 competitors took the firing line during the days of July 14 and 15 as the prestigious national-level events welcomed some of the best shots in the country.

As in previous years, the Army Marksmanship Unit (AMU) proved their stellar status in the competitive shooting realm. Overtaking the National Trophy Individual (NTI) event was SSG Greg Markowski, 44, of the AMU with a score of 291-13x – just one point over fellow AMU member, SGT Christopher Hudock.

SSG Markowski went on to become the Overall Service Pistol competitor of the CMP National Pistol Matches, while Hudock, 28, topped the prestigious President's Pistol Match.

Markowski, Hudock, along with teammates SGT Anthony Heinauer and SFC Patrick Franks, combined scores to capture the National Team Trophy event for the U.S. AMU for the twelfth year, with a score of 1120-29x.

The event was the last for SFC Patrick Franks, who is retiring from the AMU this year. He leaves behind him a memorable legacy with the team as a winner of multiple prominent National Matches events, including last year's NTI event, and also set several National Records over his career. Good luck, SFC Franks, with your future endeavors, and thank you for your years of service.

Making a mark of her own in the NTI event was Cadet Lisa Emmert, 22, of the Army National Guard, who claimed the National Woman's Trophy as the high female competitor of the match. Cadet Emmert was also the High Woman of the President's Pistol event and was the recipient of the Rose Krelstein Trophy as the high female competitor of the President's/NTI Aggregate. A proven talented competitor, Emmert currently holds the National Record score in the Junior President's Pistol Match, which she set back in 2015.

In Excellence-in-Competition (EIC) events, winning the M9 EIC Match, which accompanies the Pistol Small Arms Firing School, was civilian Roy Leidy, 55, of Northampton, PA, who earned a score of 269-1x to overtake the match by just one point. Dillon Carr, 17, of San Diego, CA, was the High Junior of the match and finished fourth place overall.

SFC Adam Sokolowski, 39, of the AMU, led the Service Pistol EIC Match, with a score of 291-8x, as John Ennis, 42, of Honolulu, HI, snatched the .22 Rimfire Pistol EIC Match, with a score of 294-13x.

Sam Kwon, 19, of New York, NY, was the High Junior in the .22 Rimfire Pistol EIC Match and received the G.P. Perry DeFino Trophy for his win in the Junior Individual Match for the second consecutive year and for the third time over his career. He and New York Rifle & Pistol Junior teammate, Heather Powers, joined forces to earn the top spot in the Junior Team event.

Powers, 18, of West Falls, NY, outshot Kwon in the Junior President's Pistol Match by nearly 10 points to claim the win.

"She is phenomenal. She was definitely carrying me in the NRA matches," Kwon said with a laugh. "She's a great teammate and we both work really well together."

Kwon, a National Matches competitor since 2014 and often at the top of the podium at the national level, says he tries to ignore his past performances and avoids thinking about scores while on the line – focusing only on the fundamentals each time he pulls the trigger.

"In my mind, score is a reflection of technique, and I also get nervous if I check scores, so I try not to do that," he said.

Still, Kwon admits that he can't help but be just a little intimidated by the talents of his New York teammate.

"She definitely scares me," he joked. "We're both shooting really well, and I'm happy that we're both shooting really well."

Kwon went on to be named the Overall Junior Pistol marksman by a 50-point margin.

Lowe Claims Win in AiR 15 Challenge at 2018 National Matches Air Gun Events

CAMP PERRY, Ohio – Winning this year's AiR 15 Challenge during the National Matches Air Gun series of events was SPC Daniel Lowe, 25, of the U.S. Army Reserve team. The match was fired on August 4 at the Gary Anderson CMP Competition Center, located at the Camp Perry National Guard Training Facility.

During the Challenge, competitors fire in a 20 Shot Match using AiR-15 lead pellet air guns that mirror the look of high-power service rifles. The Top 20 then compete in a shoulder-to-shoulder Shoot Off, with the overall winner of the event determined through an elimination challenge.

Lowe is no stranger to the air gun range. A past champion and medalist at the national level in air rifle, he qualified for the 2016 U.S. Summer Olympic team after finishing in second place in the qualifying match, held at Camp Perry.

"I walk through those doors (to the Camp Perry air range), and immediately, goosebumps," he said with a smile. "My heart rate goes up, I get a little excited – 'Hey, I remember this place!'"

Lowe said he even secured his AiR Challenge win on the firing point directly across from where he established his place on the men's 10-meter and 50-meter air rifle Olympic teams two years earlier.

He's taken a break from air rifle competition since December 2016, focusing more on service rifle as a member of the U.S. Army Marksmanship Unit team, then moving to the Reserve team in January 2018. During the 2018 National Matches high-power events, Lowe was a member of the overall winning team in the famous "Rattle Battle," National Infantry Trophy Team event.

Though no longer in training for air rifle, Lowe says the years he put in for the discipline in the past ultimately prepared him for any marksmanship competition he enters.

"The fundamentals are all there," he said. "All of those many, many hours of hard work kind of shined through."

Since leaving active duty, he's been busy adjusting to civilian life and starting his own business in Washington – a coaching company for air gun and smallbore shooters in the Pacific Northwest area of the country. In the future, he's also hoping to keep working towards earning a spot onto the podium in the highpower realm.

Both air pistol and air rifle events were held during the National Matches air gun series. Last year's AiR 15 winner, SGT Nick Mowrer, led the 30 Shot Air Pistol event by one point, with a score of 288-9x.

A Top Center Shot was awarded during the 30 Shot Pistol Match to the competitor who fired the closest shot to center. This year's winner was Paul Lalancette, 57, of Attleboro, MA. For his win, Paul received a monetary prize of \$197.00 from the CMP, based on the number of entries. The next seven closest competitors also received money for their efforts.

A Center Shot was also awarded in the 20 Shot Sporter Rifle Event, with Wynn Lekhavanija, 18, of Ellicott City, MD, earning the top prize money.

A series of Bench League rifle matches, fired from a fixed position, were also held during the month. Rodney Snyder, 62, of Fremont, OH, placed first in the 30 Shot AR-15 match, as Miki Marciiniak, 61, of Macomb, MI, fired the overall score in the 30 Shot Sporter event for the second consecutive year. Gavin Barnick, 15, of Mora, MN, took home the win in the precision 30 Shot Bench Match.
