



Civilian Marksmanship Program's Winter Home Range Series



The CMP is pleased to announce a series of home range matches for winter 2020-2021. These matches will be fired indoor in .22 pistol, air rifle, air pistol, rimfire and smallbore disciplines. Scores from all local matches will be compiled into one match (similar to a postal event). Awards will be sent to overall winners. This is a great way to get a national ranking without leaving your local range! Each competitor will receive a winter hat and match decal for their participation.

Athletes can only fire in each event one time.

Safety

The CMP would like to remind clubs to follow all state and local health guidelines and safe range practices. We also recommend each club follow guidelines to keep their facilities safe, such as: following state and local laws and adherence to health advisories, limiting/spacing the number of participants who congregate for safety briefings, spacing out firing points, leaving empty firing points between shooters, ensuring participants wear masks, covering their nose and mouth, washing hands frequently and/or providing disinfectant wipes and continuously cleaning common surfaces such as shooting benches & equipment.

Sanctioning

Each local match will be sanctioned by a CMP Affiliated Club. Matches should be fired by February 16, 2021. All results will become final on February 24th.

A special match sanctioning form will be available on the CMP website. Match sanctioning fee will be \$10 per event plus \$5 per shooter. This is due when results are submitted.

Events

.22 Pistol – 40 Shot, 50ft*
Air Pistol – 60 Shots, 10m
Air Rifle – 3x20 (including a team match), 10m
Air Rifle – 60 Shots Standing (decimal score), 10m
Rimfire Sporter, 50ft
Smallbore 3x20, 50ft
Smallbore Prone (60 Shots), 50ft (Sling, F-Class)

Rules

The air Rifle 3x20 and 60 shot standing matches will be governed by the [National Three-Position Air Rifle Council rulebook](#). The 60-shot match will be open to all ages, but the 3x20 is restricted to school-aged athletes (Rule 3.1).

Rimfire Sporter Match

This match will be shot at 50 and 25 feet

It will consist of:

- 10 rounds 50 feet slow fire prone
- 10 rounds 50 feet rapid fire prone
- 10 rounds 50 feet slow fire sitting or kneeling
- 10 rounds 50 feet rapid fire sitting or kneeling
- 10 rounds 25 feet slow fire standing
- 10 rounds 25 feet rapid fire standing

All competitors will be entered into this match once with an O-Class, a T-Class or a TU Class. They may fire in each class at least once but may not fire in the same class more than once. There will be NO RE-ENTRY. Competitors may not average scores or override one score for another.

Awards

Results and awards will be announced on the CMP website and social media. Each competitor will receive a winter hat and decal. All other awards will be mailed and will vary by discipline.

Score Submission

Methods for score submission will vary by discipline. After sanctioning, CMP will contact the match directors with instructions. Rimfire .22 and Pistol .22 will receive scorecards. All others will receive a result spreadsheet to complete. For those clubs with the Orion scoring system, instructions will be sent for submission.
