COMPETITION OPEN TO: All Junior Sporter and Precision teams are eligible. Schools can enter as many teams as they wish. If there are enough lanes, we will allow single shooters.

CATEGORY: Sporter and precision — all rifles must be in accordance with the most current CMP rule book (Blue Book). Co2 will be available. The match director will provide compressed air, however you should bring your own fill adapter. We need at least three teams to give out awards, if there are less than three teams, we will only give out a first place award.

This is an EIC approved match.

ENTRY: All marksmen must be certified to compete through their own branch of service. All cadets must be in accordance with their individual school board policies. A list of shooters to include last, first names, birth date and CMP competition number must be forwarded to the match director at <a href="mailto:bobby.edwards@fwusd.org">bobby.edwards@fwusd.org</a> no later than one week prior to the match. Please use the attached form. You can submit as many names as you wish and finalize during check-in, this will speed the process of entering names. Coaches or team captains will draw for lane assignment after check-in. If there is room, additional shooters may participate.

RULES: Current CMP Shooting Rules will govern the competition. Coaches and cadets will insure that all team equipment conforms to CMP rules. Copies of the CMP rule book can be downloaded from the CMP web sight.

CONDUCT OF FIRE: This match will be a 3x 20, with no finals.

Out of town schools will have priority in match times. Please e-mail the match director for match times. Targets will be provided, schools must provide ammunition.

COACHING: Precision coaching will not be permitted after the sighters have been engaged. Sporter coaches can use non-verbal coaching during the competition.

A "Jury" composed of three disinterested individuals will be formed to settle any controversial matters as directed by the Match Director.

SCORING PROTESTS: All targets will be posted 30 minutes after the match is fired. Protests can be made by both coaches and shooters. Protests will be handled in accordance with rule 8.5.

AWARDS: Awards will be determined by the number of teams entered. If more than 5 teams enter in a category, the top three teams will receive trophies and individual medals for each team member and the top three in each positions will also receive a medal along with top three overall marksmen. If less than 5 teams enter in a category, then only the first place team will receive a trophy and individual medals. The position medals will still be awarded.

RANGE LOCATION: Flowing Wells High School is located freeway 10, exit Prince Road, make a left on N. Caballero Place and the JROTC is located ¼ mile on your left.

ENTRY FEES: A \$50.00 team entry fee will be paid on arrival. Prefer cash or check made out to the match director. Please email the match director with the number of teams you will be entering.
