Precision Pistol Clinic and 1800
with
National Pistol Champion Jonathan Shue
Saturday April 26th, 2025
Rain or Shine



Description: Jonathan Shue, past and current National Pistol Champion, will be at Pelham Fish & Game on Saturday, the 26th of April, 2025 to conduct a Precision Pistol Clinic with both classroom and live fire instruction. Following the clinic, a CMP Precision Pistol 1800 will be conducted (.22 and CF or .22 only). Cost for the clinic is \$70, and cost for the 1800 is \$30. PF&G members save \$25 (\$75 for both clinic and match). Shooters can participate in either, or both, with priority for those participating in both.

Range: 50 yard slow fire; 25 yard timed & rapid fire. 50 covered outdoor firing points.

Directions to the Range: 100 Simpson Mill Road, Pelham, NH 03076 From points south: Rt. 93 North to exit 2. Make a right at the exit light. (*) Make a right at next light (South Policy). Make a right at next light (Lowell Rd). Follow for approx 3 miles. Make a right onto Hobbs Rd (you will see signs for Pelham Fish and Game). Make next right onto Simpson Mill Rd. PF&G is about ½ mile on the right. Pistol range is located to left and rear of the main clubhouse. From Points North: Rt. 93 South to exit 2. Make a right at end of exit ramp. Follow the same directions as above from (*) point.

Eligibility: Clinic is open to all safe shooters (members and non-members). Junior shooters (under 18 years old) must be accompanied by an adult.

Registration and Fees:

- **Clinic Only:** A package fee of \$70.00 includes approximately 2 hours of classroom instruction, followed by 3 hours of hands-on live fire instruction.
- **CMP Registered 1800:** Immediately following live-fire training, there will be a CMP registered 1800 for .22/CF or .22 only. Match fee for the 1800 is \$30
- Firm reservations will be taken via cash (in person), check (made out to Pelham Fish & Game, sent to Matt Bartel, 58 Winnicutt Rd. Stratham NH 03885, Venmo (@fa18hooker), or Zelle (fa18hooker@hotmail.com). Please annotate "Shue Clinic" on your payment. Confirmation of your reservation will be sent to your included email. If you do not receive confirmation, email fa18hooker@hotmail.com with your information.

Advance registration is required to guarantee your squadding. A waiting list will be created after the first 50 registrants. No refunds after March 1st, 2025, regardless of reason for cancellation. Clinic and match will be conducted rain or shine.

Food: Water is provided. Lunch is included in the match fees.

Start Time: Saturday, 26 April, 2025. **Classroom Instruction, Main Clubhouse:** 0800-1000 **Live Fire Clinic, PF&G Covered 50 yard range:** 1000-1300, with lunch served during instruction. **CMP 1800, PF&G Covered 50 yard range:** 1300-1600. **NOTE:** These times are approximate, and will change. If you are planning on attending only a portion of the clinic, or only the 1800, arrive early.

Rules: Current CMP Rules will govern as appropriate. Competitors are required to be familiar with the contents of the current rule book. An **Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI)** is required in all CMP sanctioned pistol competitions to indicate that the slide is open and the chamber is empty.

Classification: Current CMP classifications will be used. Competitors must show a valid current outdoor classification or score record book. All unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.

Firearms: 22 caliber, and Center Fire per CMP Rules for Precision Pistol. Triggers may be weighed, and **will** be weighed, if National Records are broken.

Scoring: Competitors will pass score cards to the right and score the competitor to the left, unless otherwise directed. Plugs and gauges will be used ONLY by designated range personnel. Competitors are responsible for repairing their own targets. Bring your own stapler, repair pasties/tape and small clipboard. A 3-man jury will be selected, if there is a challenge. A \$3.00 challenge fee will be paid for each challenge and refunded, if the challenge is upheld.

Targets: All slow fire will be on NRA B-6 50-yard slow fire targets. All timed and rapid fire will be on NRA B-8 25-yard targets. Targets and repair centers will be provided.

Award Schedule: There will be no awards.
