Position Summary: Target Specialist will be responsible for the maintenance, support, set up,

tear down, technical support, and training related to CMP's Electronic KTS and Megalink Targets at CMP North including Petrarca Range as well as all electronic targets housed at CMP North. The role ensures targets are

maintained, operational, and ready for events.

Supplementary job

Responsible for overseeing the CMP North electronic systems to include the pistol range set-up, trouble shooting and tear-down. Guidance will be

provided by CMP Management Team.

Positions Dimensions: Specific program and job assignments are determined by the Chief Programs Officer and are subject to change. Assignments include:

Setup, maintenance, and teardown of electronic targets for events

- and matches.
- Provide technical support for electronic targets during events.
- Coordinate transportation of electronic targets.
- Maintain all electronic targets at CMP North and ensure event readiness.
- Develop and maintain Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for electronic target use and troubleshooting.
- Train staff and target techs using SOP guidelines.
- Respond promptly to emails and calls, even during busy periods.
- Oversee the annual target schedule, including packing, shipping, and event setup/teardown.
- Ensure proper targets and supplies are delivered to pits before events.
- Troubleshoot technical issues during events.
- Collaborate with IT on technical upgrades or issues.
- Oversee NM Target Tech staff, train them to operate tablets, and assist competitors as needed.
- Provide vacation and sick time requests in advance to your supervisor. Coordinate schedule changes and overtime approval in advance with your supervisor.
- Ensure proper forms for travel are completed in advance and trips are approved in advance by your supervisor.
- Complete Purchase order requests in advance with manager's guidance and follow company procedures.
- Assist with other programs, competitions, or administrative tasks during high-demand periods.
- Follow and ensure all CMP policies and procedures are followed and adhered to.
- Adhere to CMP policies and communicate with the Programs Management Team.
- All other duties as assigned.

Medium — The work of a target specialist directly impacts the production and success of CMP's programs, events, and sales. Fulfilling job duties accurately and precisely is necessary to ensure the company's success and fulfill the CMP's mission.

Qualifications

Education/Experience: High school diploma or the equivalent. Knowledge in competitive shooting events and prior CMP Target system training is essential. Knowledge of KTS and Megalink target systems is desirable. Experience in teaching is a plus.

Skills/Training: Proficiency in CMP target systems, setup, and competition guidelines. Familiarity with CMP shooting disciplines. Strong computer skills, including MS Word, Excel, and proprietary software. Low voltage knowledge to include relays, diodes and voltmeter reading is desirable. Effective communication skills for working with affiliates, vendors, and competitors.

Travel is required. A valid driver's license is required for travel and driving CMP owned vehicles. Completion of Safe Sport Certification is mandatory.
