

Squadding Update – 2025 National Rimfire Sporter Match

We're looking forward to seeing you to the 2025 Rimfire Sporter Match! Over the past few months, we've heard from many of you—through comments, questions, and suggestions—and we've taken that feedback to heart. After reviewing your input and evaluating our match procedures, we're making some updates this year to improve your experience and reduce time on the firing line.

Here's some enhancements you need to know:

No Scorecards This Year

We'll be using electronic targets exclusively for scoring—no paper scorecards required. Your shots will be automatically tallied and displayed on your monitor during the match. If you'd like to keep a record of your scores, you're welcome to take a photo of your screen at the end of your relay.

No Score Verifiers Needed

Originally, we scheduled relays in pairs so competitors could verify scores for each other. Since we're no longer using scorecards, there's no need for score verifiers, allowing for a smoother, faster flow on the range.

Squadding Just Got Easier

Competitors can now shoot back-to-back relays, if preferred. If you'd like to update your squadding assignment, we're happy to help! Please note that requests will be processed in the order registrations were received, with priority given to those who registered first.
