Non-Alabama residents are permitted to participate in the match but are ineligible for qualifying scores or awards.

Teams:

Four-person teams will be declared prior to the first shot of the match. No athlete may shoot on more than one team (reference Rule 3.2.6 Membership on More Than One Team).

Event:

3PAR 3x20 State Championship

Course of Fire:

Kneeling-Prone-Standing

Finals:

Finals will be a Three-Position Start-From-Zero Finals for the top eight Precision and top eight Sporter athletes (reference Rule 10.3 Three-Position Start-From-Zero Final). Only the top eight athletes in each class will be eligible for Finals. If an athlete leaves and fails to return or chooses not to participate, Finals will proceed with less than eight athletes in that class. **It is the athlete's responsibility to be present and prepared in time to participate (reference Rule 10.2.4 Finalist Reporting and 8.6.1 Ties in Events or Positions with No Finals (or Before Finals)).**

Compliance Check:

Athletes are subject to equipment, clothing, and registration verification checks to ensure compliance with current regulations (reference Rule 7.3 Equipment Control).

**NOTE: Athletes are prohibited from shooting barefoot and Sporter class athletes are prohibited from wearing footwear that covers the athlete's ankles (reference 4.3.2 Shoes). Boots and high top shoes are strictly forbidden for Sporter Class athletes.**

Schedule:

**Relay start times are firm and will not be adjusted for athletes arriving late, though it MAY be possible to switch relays. NOTE: If entries exceed relay capacity, times will be adjusted to incorporate additional relays.**

Relay 1:	3-PAR 3 x 20	9:00 a.m.
Relay 2:	3-PAR 3 x 20	11:30 a.m.
Finals:	Three-Position Finals	Following last relay

**NOTE: Calls to the line will occur 30 minutes before the scheduled relay start times (i.e., 8:30 and 11:00 a.m.). Sighting and Preparation periods will begin eight minutes before the scheduled relay start times (i.e., 8:52 and 11:22 a.m.). Record shots for each relay will begin promptly as scheduled.**

### EIC Points:

The match is sanctioned and EIC points will be awarded (reference Appendix C Junior EIC Award Program Regulations).

### Awards:

Individual Placement and Awards – Determined by Finals scores. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place individuals in both the Sporter and Precision classes will receive medallions.

Four-Person Team Placement and Awards – Determined by match scores (excluding Finals results). The highest scoring Sporter and Precision class teams will be awarded Alabama CMP State Director's Cups. The top four athletes from each 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place team will receive medallions.

Junior Achievement Award Pins – Determined by match scores (excluding Finals results) and will be awarded to athletes who achieve the following:

Sporter:	510+ (Gold)	480-509 (Silver)	440-479 (Bronze)
Precision:	580+ (Gold)	560-579 (Silver)	540-559 (Bronze)

State Championship: The top Sporter and Precision teams, and the top Sporter and Precision individuals, not on the top team, firing a minimum qualification score will qualify for the CMP National Championship. This invitation is only good for the winners. **Invitations will NOT be passed down.** State winners must be from Alabama. Minimum cut scores are as follows:

Sporter:	500 Individual	2000 Team
Precision:	550 Individual	2200 Team

In addition to the state winners, the following scores will automatically qualify individuals and teams for the CMP National Championship.

Sporter:	525 Individual	2050 Team
Precision:	580 Individual	2275 Team
