Along with remote locations including the Reading Rifle Club in Reading MA. The match is a junior three-position air rifle match that is a sanctioned CMP Cup Match and an outstanding competition opportunity for every school or junior club shooting team.

This event is named after our Director of the Civilian Marksmanship Emeritus, Gary Anderson; whose influence and guidance has significantly impacted the success of three-position air rifle shooting. We sincerely hope you and your team will join us in Reading for a great competition.

The National Three Position Air Rifle Council sanctions this three-position air rifle invitational as an open CMP Cup match.

Times	Saturday November 14th, 2026 1st relay 9am to 11am (20 spots) 2nd relay 11pm to 1pm (20 spots) 3rd relay 1pm to 3pm will be added when relays 1 and 2 are full A 3p final will be held for the top 8 competitors in relays 1 - 2 and 3 (if needed) at the completion of the final relay. May it be relay 2 or 3. The finals will be a 3p air final. Separate awards will be given for the final.
	All competitors will fire a three-position 3X20 course of fire in order of Kneeling, Prone and Standing followed by a 10-shot final at the completion of the 3p match. The individual 3X20 scores fired by the four members on each team will be used to determine team winners.
Location:	Reading Rifle and Revolver Club, Reading MA
Teams:	Teams will consist of 4 Firing Junior Members. Teams are to be declared before firing begins.
Rules:	The competition will be governed by the 2024-2026 National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules. Copies of the rules may be downloaded from the CMP website at http://thecmp.org/youth/air/national-standard-three-position-air-rifle-rules/ . The match is

	sanctioned by the National Three-Position Air Rifle Council as a CMP Cup Match so that scores may be recognized as National Records and competitors can earn EIC credit points that count towards earning the Junior Distinguished Badge.																										
Course of Fire:	Air Rifle : 3 x 20, 20 kneeling, 20 prone, 20 off-hand																										
Time limits:	Prep and sighting time (Kneeling) - 8 minutes Kneeling 20 minutes, 5 min change over to prone, 5 min prep and sighting for prone, 20 min for prone, 5 min change over to standing, 5 min prep and sighting, 25 min for standing.																										
Rifle:	Air Rifle: Any .177 cal. Air rifle (co2 or compressed air), rule 4.6																										
Sights:	Metallic sights only; Rule 4.2.5																										
Targets:	Air Rifle – Sius Electronic Target Systems																										
Distance:	Air Rifle – Ten (10) meters																										
Coaching:	Coaching will not be permitted.																										
Awards:	Individual Awards: Top 3 competitors in the sporter and precision classes will receive championship medallion.
